How to configure email notifications



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1 Introduction

This document explains the workflow of sending different notifications to students, where notification content depends on the session type they are assigned to.




2 Setting the message templates

You can create the "Session instructions" messages through the system parameter and set the default one that will automatically appear when creating a testing session, depending on whether it is a private or public session.

To do that, follow the steps below:

1. Navigate "System" in the main menu and choose "Settings and customization".



- 2. Enter the side-tab "Message templates" and click on the "Add new message templates" button.
- 3. The "Add new message template" pop-up will appear where you need to configure the message template. To do that, follow the next steps:
 - 3.1. Enter the name of the message template you are creating.
 - 3.2. Optionally add its description.
 - 3.3. Select the language in which you want to enter the desired message.
 - 3.3.1.Let's first select "English".

<u>Note</u>: You can add the same messages in French and English. Once you create the individual testing session, the displayed language message will correspond to the language preference set on the test.

- 3.3.2.Enter the desired message and click on the "Save text" button.
- 3.3.3.Select "French".
- 3.3.4.Enter the desired message and click on the "Save text" button.

<u>Note:</u> You need to create a default message template for both public (self-enrollment option enabled) and private (self-enrollment option disabled) testing session.


- 4. Select the message template you want to appear automatically when creating a public testing session.
- 5. Select the message template you want to appear automatically when creating a private testing session.




3 Creating testing session

3.1 Individual testing session

To create the individual testing session, navigate "Tests" in the main menu and choose "Manage tests".




Use the search box to find the test for which you want to create an individual testing session, and click on the name of the test to open it.






Click on the "**Testing session**" button on the "**New testing session**" tab. The pop-up window will appear where you need to enter information about the individual testing session you are creating.




The "Candidate self-enrollment" option is disabled by default when creating the individual testing session. This means that this testing session will automatically shown the message you previously set in the "Private session – session instructions" parameter.



Note: The language of the displayed message depends on the language preference of the test.




Suppose that the "English" is set in the language preference of the "A/P exam". Then the default message for the "Session instructions" will be in English.






3.2 Common testing session

To create the individual testing session, navigate "Tests" in the main menu and choose "Testing locations".




Create the common session on the desired testing location by the "**Create common session**" icon on the FRENCH location. The default message template will be first created a template in the system settings.






To change the default message template, click on the "Load from template" button and select the desired template and language on which the message should be presented.




4 Editing default notifications

To set the content of "Test published" (this is booking notification for the private sessions), Booked assignment notifications", "Notification about the canceled attempt," and "Upcoming assignment notifications" notifications, navigate to "System" and select "Settings and customization".





On the "Notifications" tab, open one by notification you should configure by clicking on the "Edit".






Given that exam instructions are contained in message templates, the notification should contain only the following:

- The common text for all candidates, regardless of a private/public session and French/English language criteria
- 2. The corresponding variables \$sessionGroupDescription\$ and \$sessionInstructions\$ are the new ones.
 - 2.1. \$sessionGroupDescription\$ This variable will allow students to get the information found in the description of the group they are a member of.

To add group description information, navigate "Users" in the main menu and choose "User groups".



Select "All groups" end enter the desired one by clicking on its name.



Note: Users will be automatically assigned to the corresponding group when their profile is sent from the IFSE to the YTM system through the API. For testing purposes, you can manually create a user group. For more information on how to do that, please read this <u>article</u>.

2.2. \$sessionInstructions\$ - This variable will ensure that all content defined in the message template is shown in the notification candidates will receive.



An example of how the "Booked assignment notifications" should be configured and what the candidate will receive is shown in the picture below.
