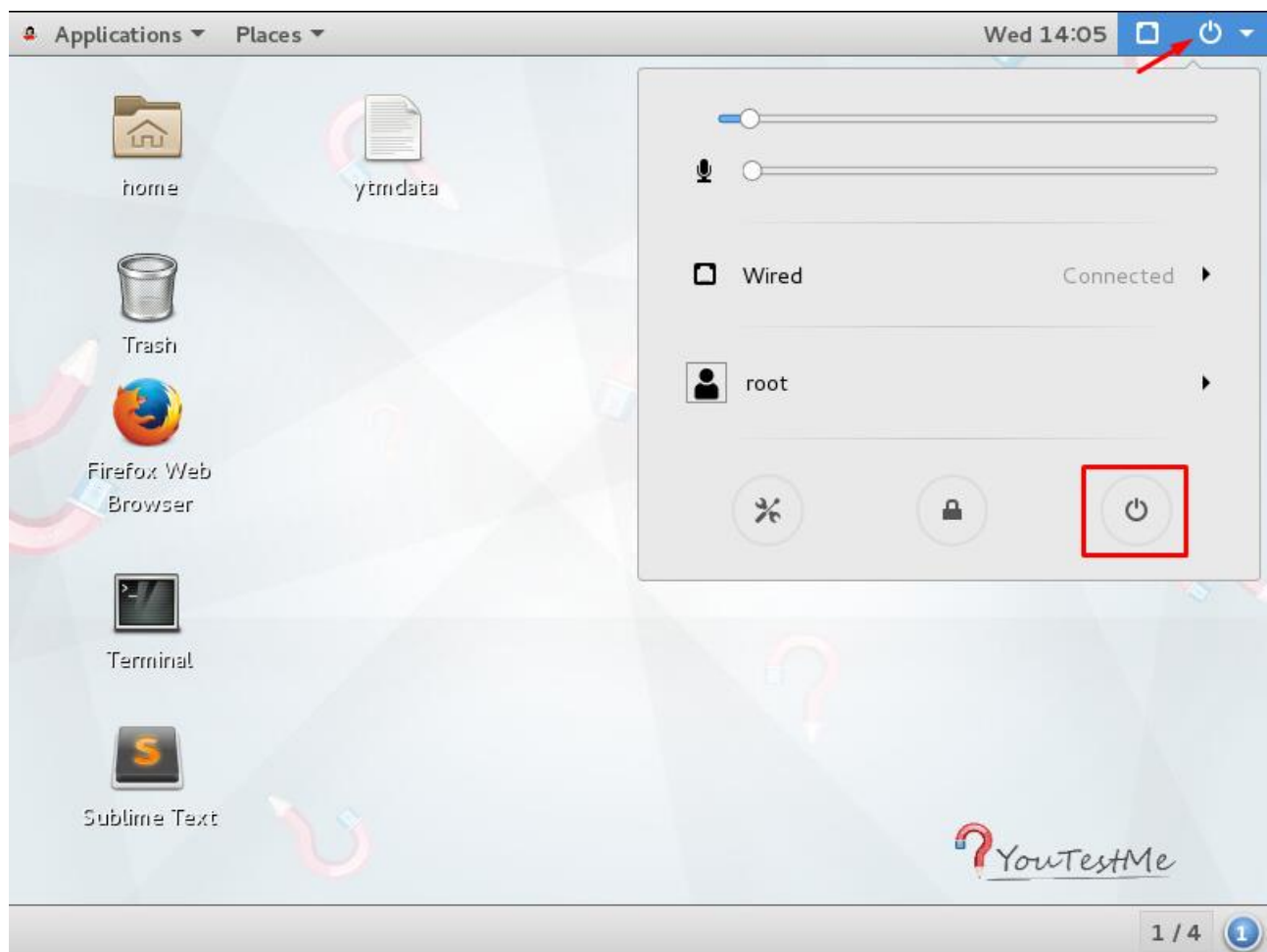
## 1 Introduction

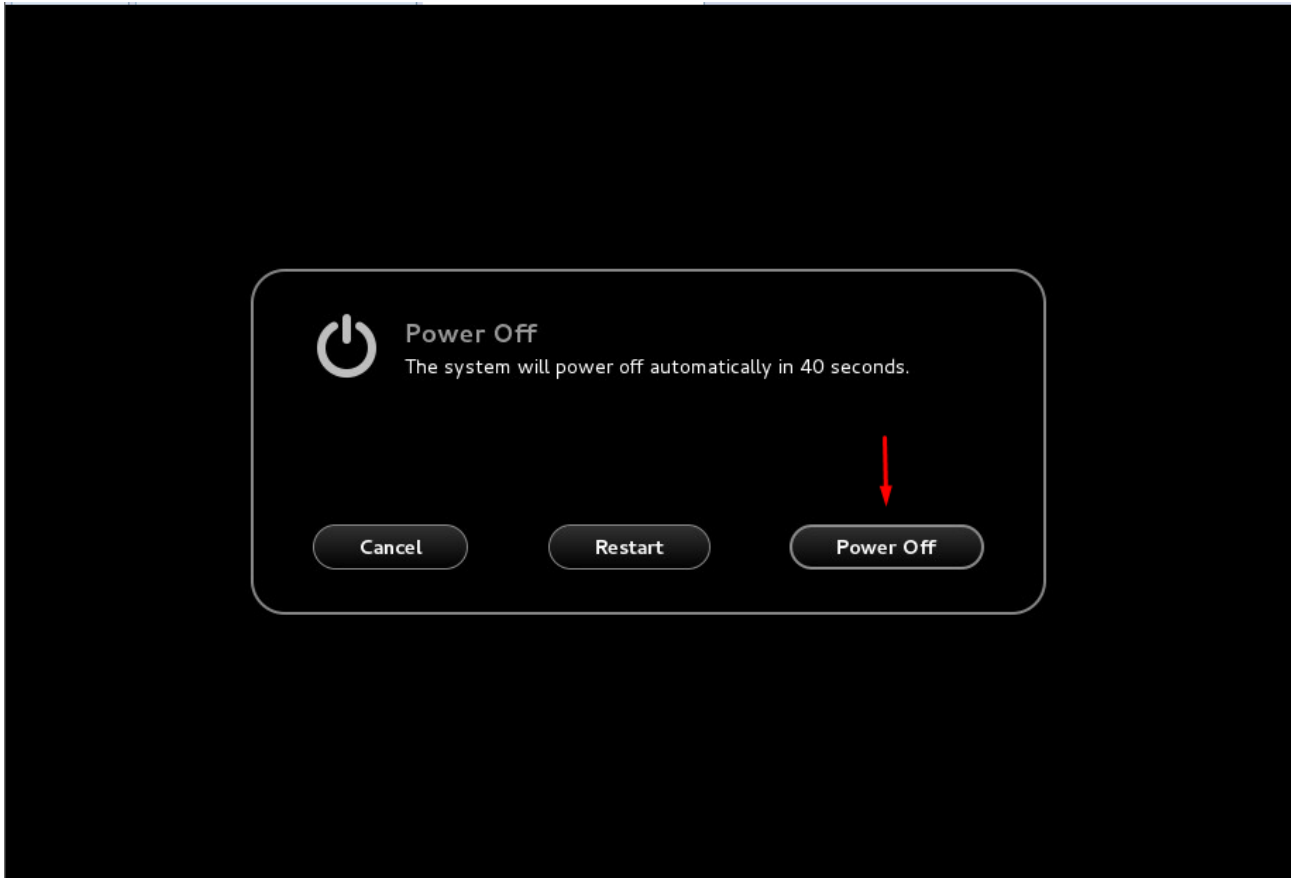
This document explains the details of the restore procedure of YouTestMe application from a snapshot. Snapshot is a convenient way of creating a light backup of the Virtual Machine, so we can easily roll back to a specific point in time.

**Important note:** We strongly suggest that you perform a snapshot of YouTestMe Virtual Machine before applying any changes.

## 2 VMware client

### 2.1 Shutdown the YouTestMe Virtual Machine

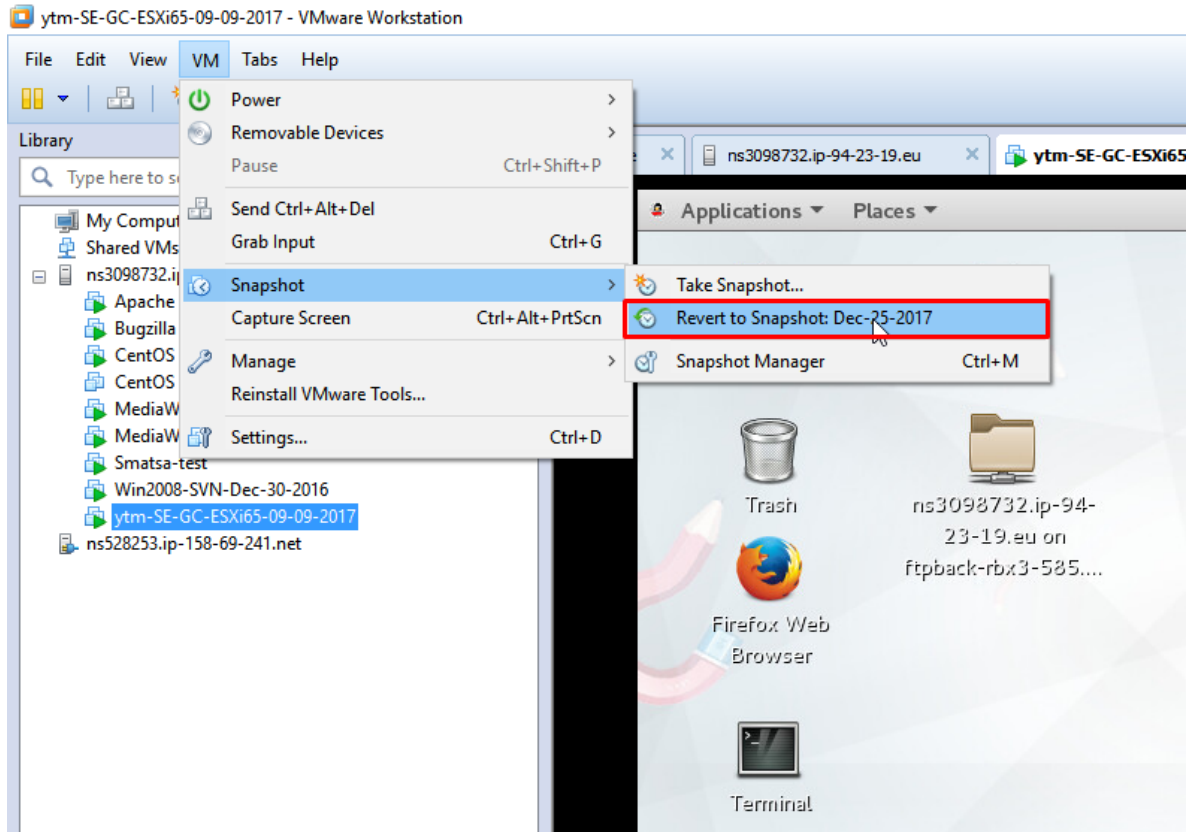




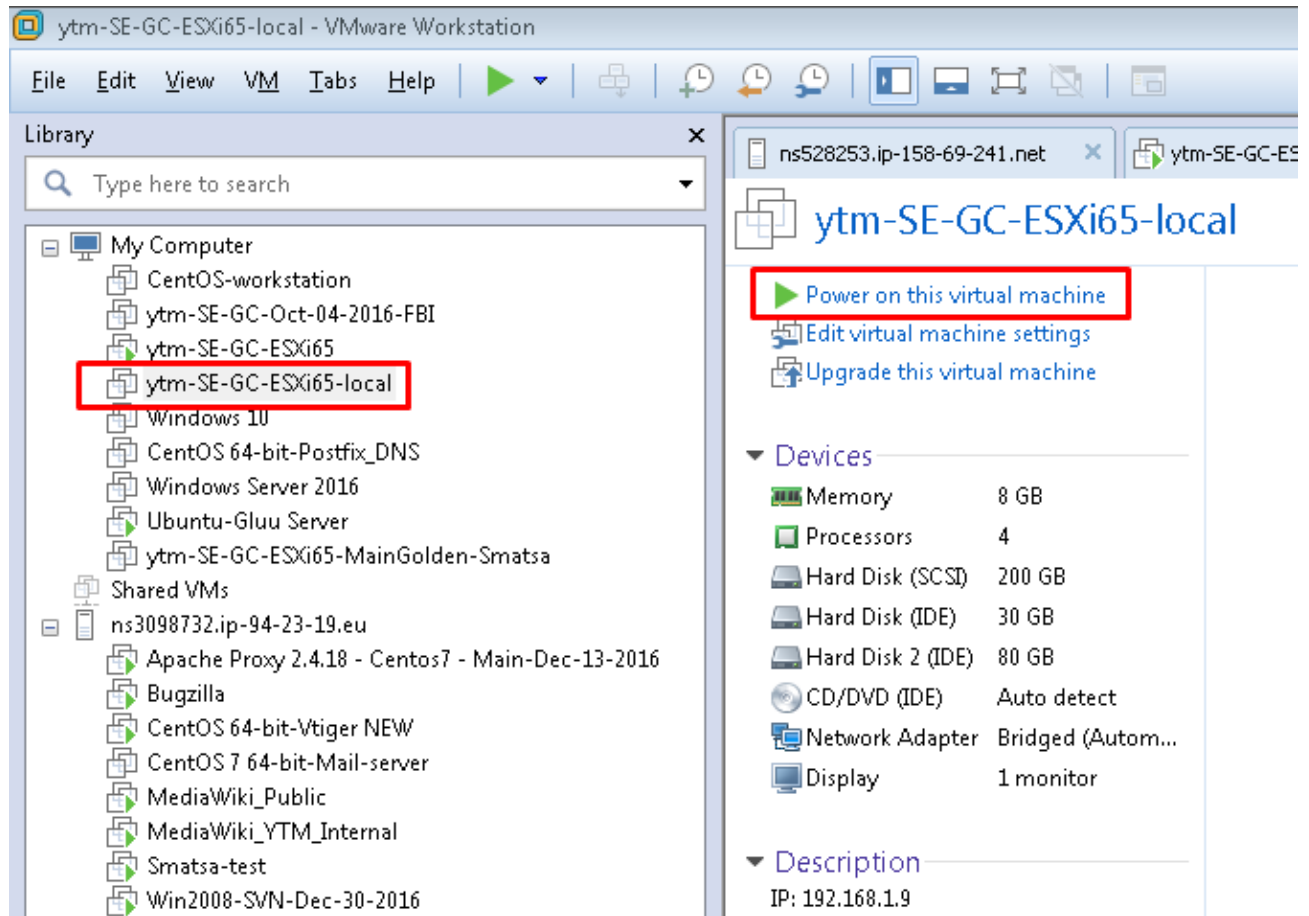
## 2.2 Perform restore operation

Select YouTestMe Virtual Machine from the list on the left side of the virtualization software and select this option:

**VM -> Snapshot -> Revert to Snapshot: *SNAPSHOT-NAME*** where *SNAPSHOT-NAME* is the name of your last snapshot (see the picture below)

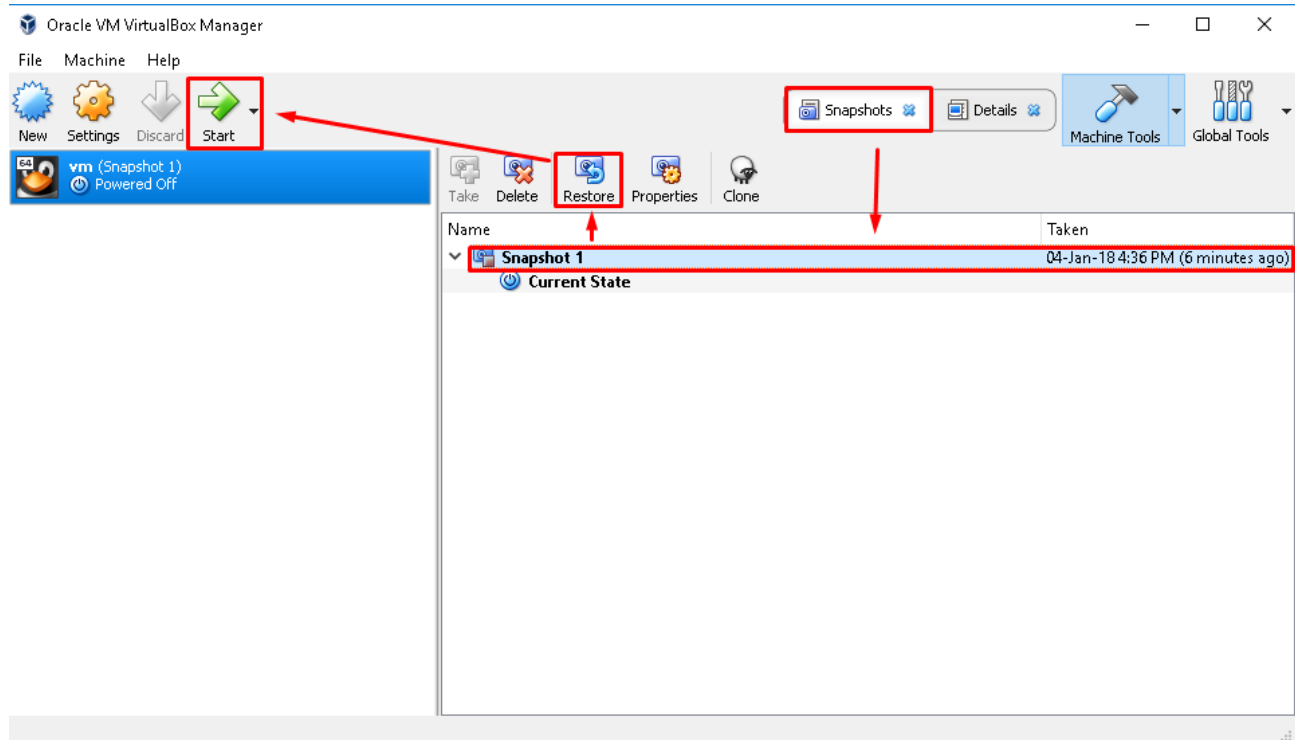


## 2.3 Power on YouTestMe Virtual Machine



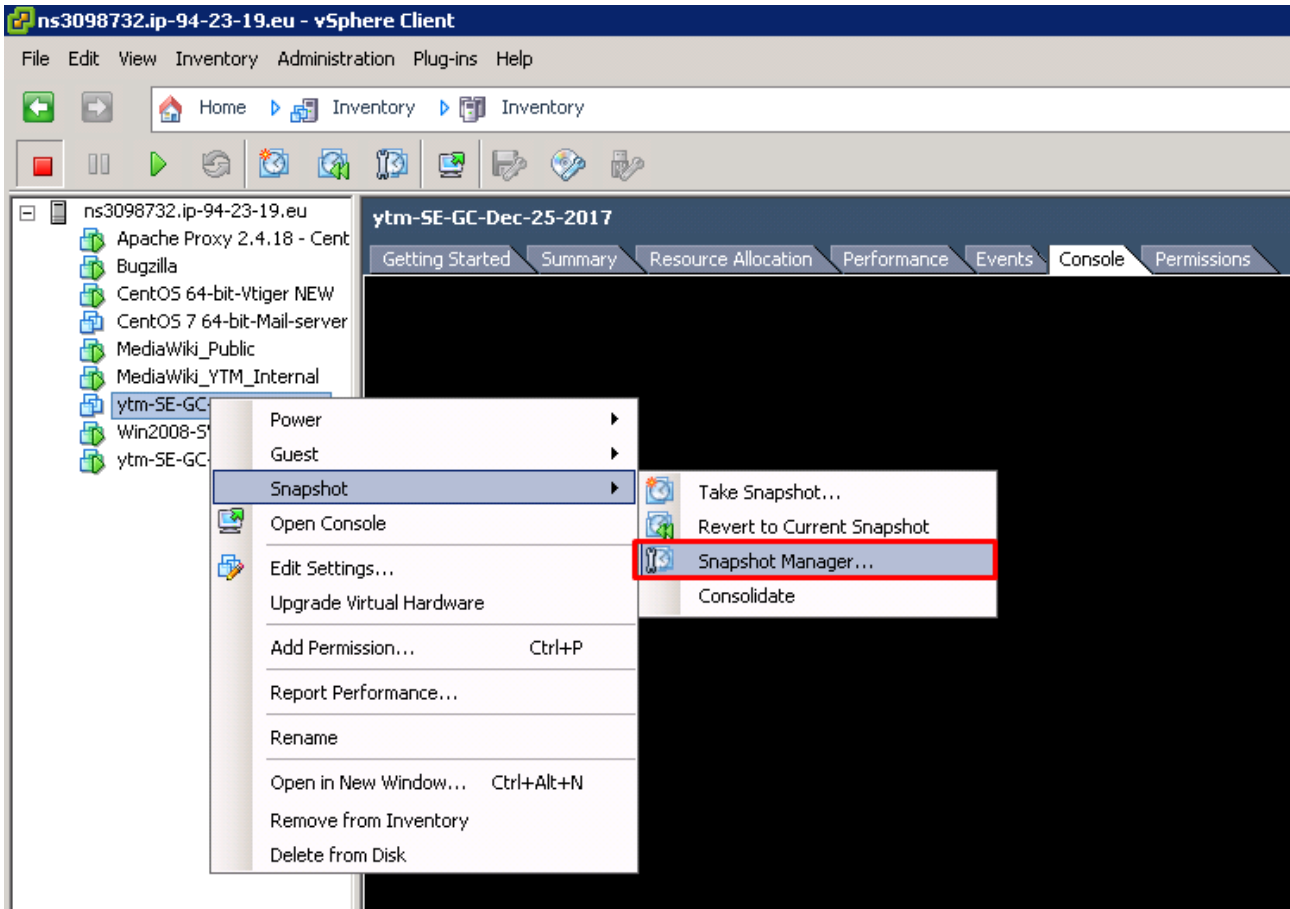
### 3 VirtualBox

1. Power off YouTestMe Virtual Machine
2. Select specific snapshot and click “Restore” button (see the picture below)
3. Power on YouTestMe Virtual Machine

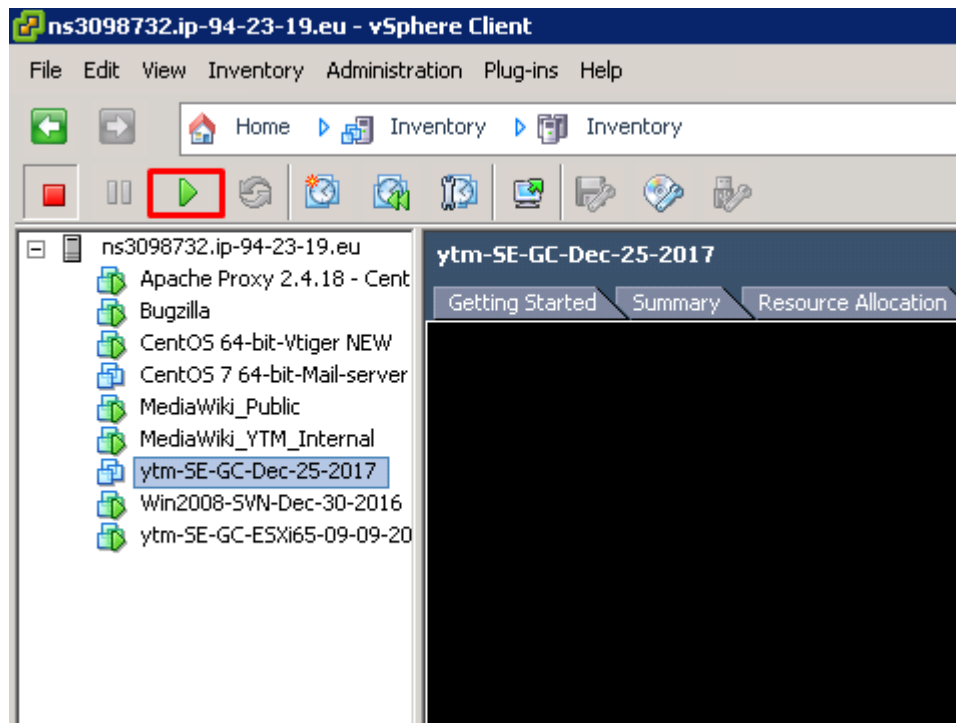
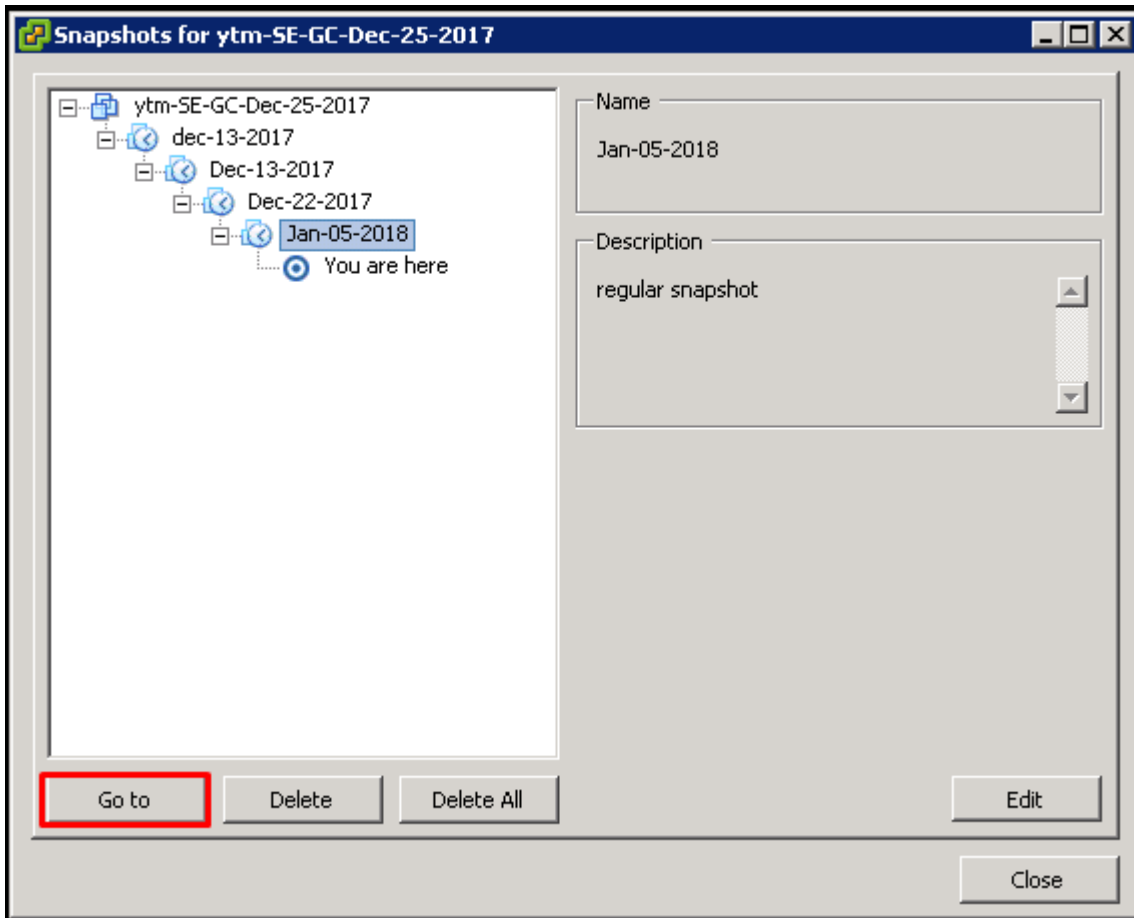


### 4 VMware vSphere client

1. Power off YouTestMe Virtual Machine
2. Select specific snapshot and click “Go to” button (see the pictures below)
3. Power on YouTestMe Virtual Machine
