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1 Introduction

YouTestMe GetCertified is a Web-based training, knowledge evaluation, certification, and surveys (LMS) application. It comprises advanced user management, question pool management, comprehensive reports, and a test generator.

2 Logging into the Application

Once you have completed the installation process and network setup on your virtual machine, according to the Installation Manual, you can access the login page using its respective URL. The login screen should resemble the picture below. Note that the logo and colors may vary depending on application branding.





2.1 User Accounts

When logging in for the first time, you can use the following accounts:

3 Mail Server

YouTestMe GetCertified supports a feature that sends email notifications for specific events (receiving test requests or role changes). To properly set up this feature, entering the mail server parameters into the administration panel is necessary. See the picture below for an example with dummy data:
