1 Introduction

IMPORTANT: We strongly suggest that you perform a snapshot and export of the YouTestMe Virtual Machine before applying any changes and verify that the virtual machine can be restored from the created export file.


2 Download

Clicking on the download link received by email, you will be prompted for the security credentials, and the download process will start automatically. Finally, you should see a patch file in the “Downloads” folder on your computer.


3 Upload the Upgrade Package

The next step should be to upload downloaded **ytm-upgrade-gc-XX.YY.ZZ.zip** file to YTM Virtual Machine using the **Upload patch** button under the **System maintenance** page (see the screenshots below).



Important note: Upload the patch file as an archive - do not extract it. The upgrade will not work if the file format is different from **.zip**.








IMPORTANT: During the upgrade process, the application will be restarted and unreachable via the browser. In case the application is unavailable for more than 5 minutes, please reboot YTM Virtual Machine.

4 Verifying the application upgrade

Refresh your page and try to login to the application. Check the application version and make sure that "8.2.12r" is available.
