

3 Creating a question group





Once you add the questions you want to be in the test ("Add questions" tab), you can assign an appropriate group to each of them. The question group allows you to organize multiple questions into a group, add its short description and multimedia (image, audio, video), displayed with each question within the group.

Note, question groups can only be added in the test, not the pool.

First, open the question by clicking the "Pencil" icon.



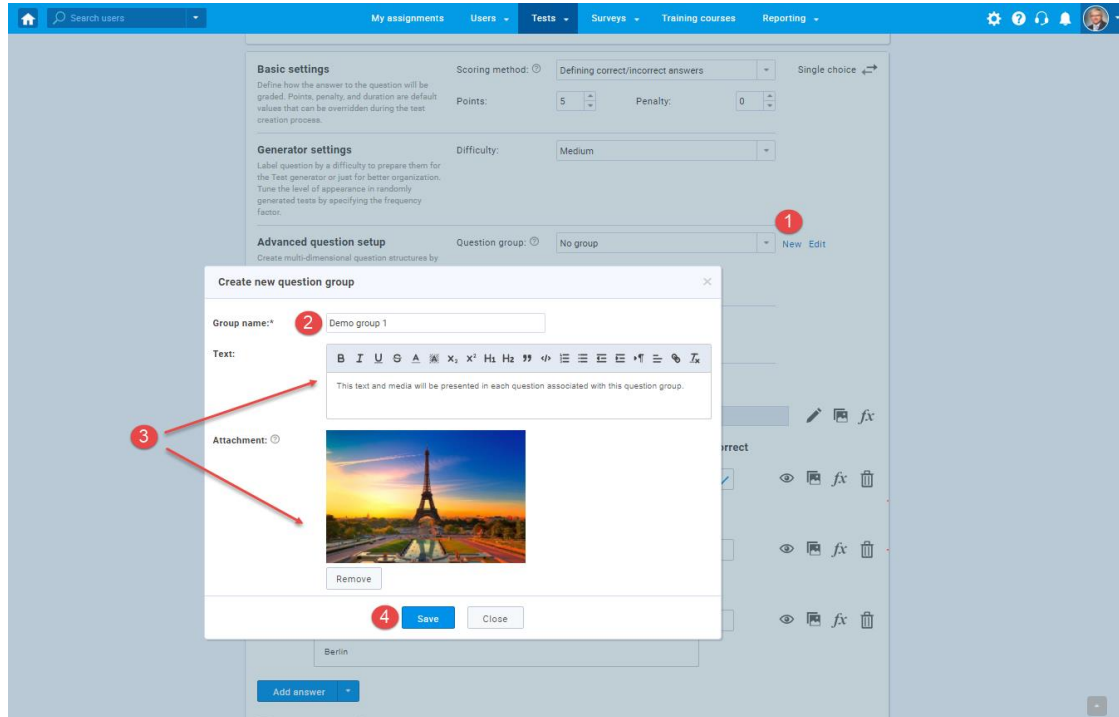

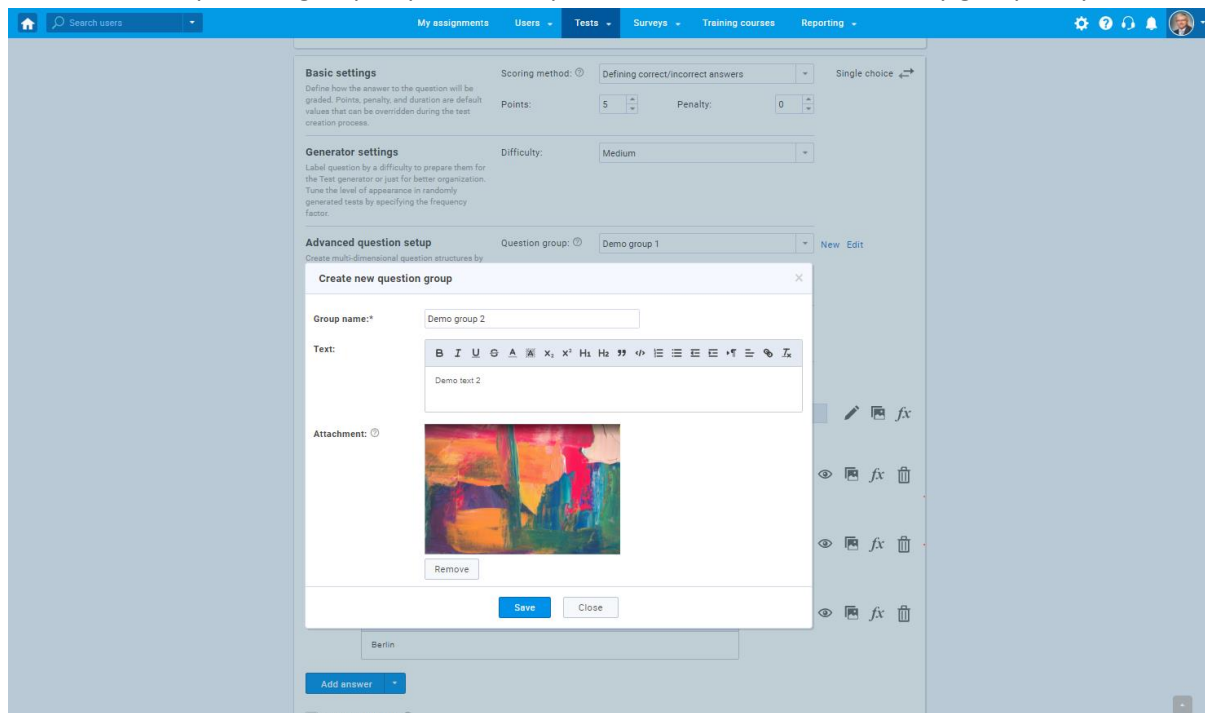

1. Click the “New” button to create a question group.
2. Enter the group name.
3. Enter text and attachment which will follow each question included in the question group.
4. Click the “Save” button.



To create another question group, repeat the steps above. You can create as many groups as you like.



Once you've created question groups, you can sort as many questions as you want into groups.

Basic settings

Define how the answer to the question will be graded. Points, penalty, and duration are default values that can be overridden during the test creation process.

Generator settings

Label question by a difficulty to prepare them for the Test generator or just for better organization. Tune the level of appearance in randomly generated tests by specifying the frequency factor.

Advanced question setup

Create multi-dimensional question structures by utilizing question branching.
Share data between questions using question grouping.

Create versions of this question in different languages.
