

1 Introduction

Required form elements or elements that require a specific format, value, or length provide this information as a text description. Text labels are associated with form input elements. Elements with multiple labels are provided in a meaningful order. Page headings and labels for form and interactive controls are informative.

2 Form elements with text descriptions




3 Text labels for input elements
