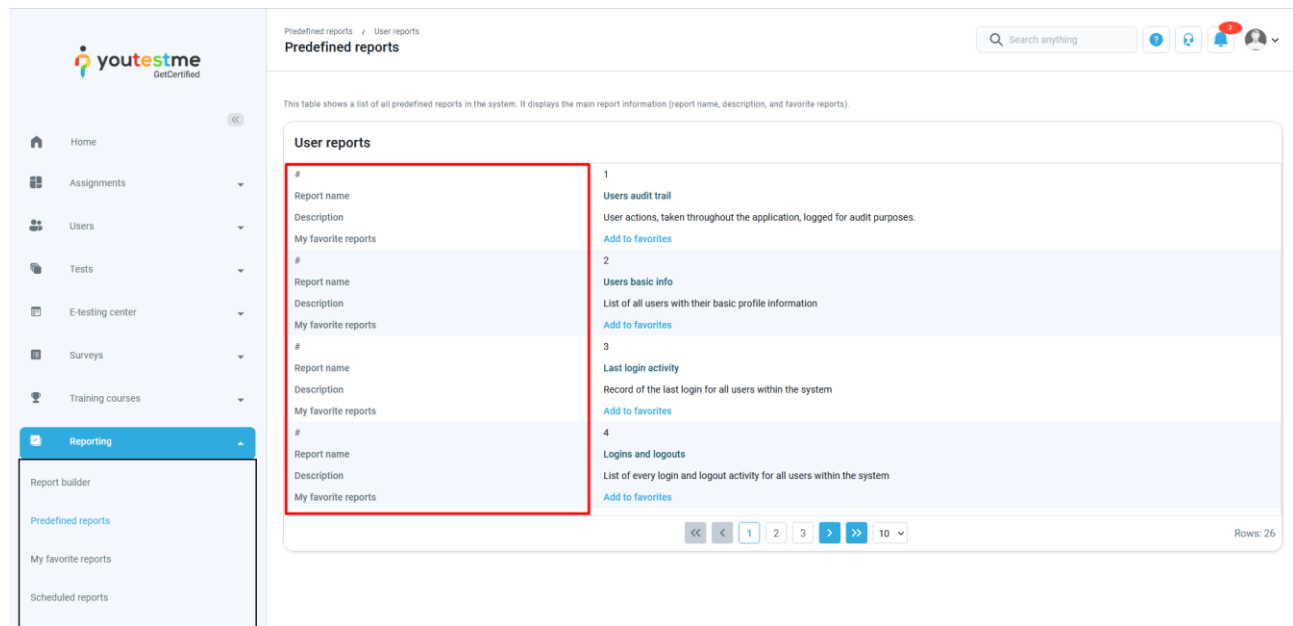

1 Introduction

This document's purpose is to show that rows are identifiable by numbering and columns by headers.

2 Column headers

All tables in the system have column header identifiers. To select a header for the screen reader to read, use the **Tab** key.




