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## 1 Introduction

This document explains how to add specific feedback to each choice option and ability to withhold feedback on tests must also be an option.

## 2 Steps

To enable the answer feedback option, you need to create a test and configure its settings regarding answer feedback.

### 2.1 Creating a test

Hover over the **Tests** in the main menu and select **New test**.

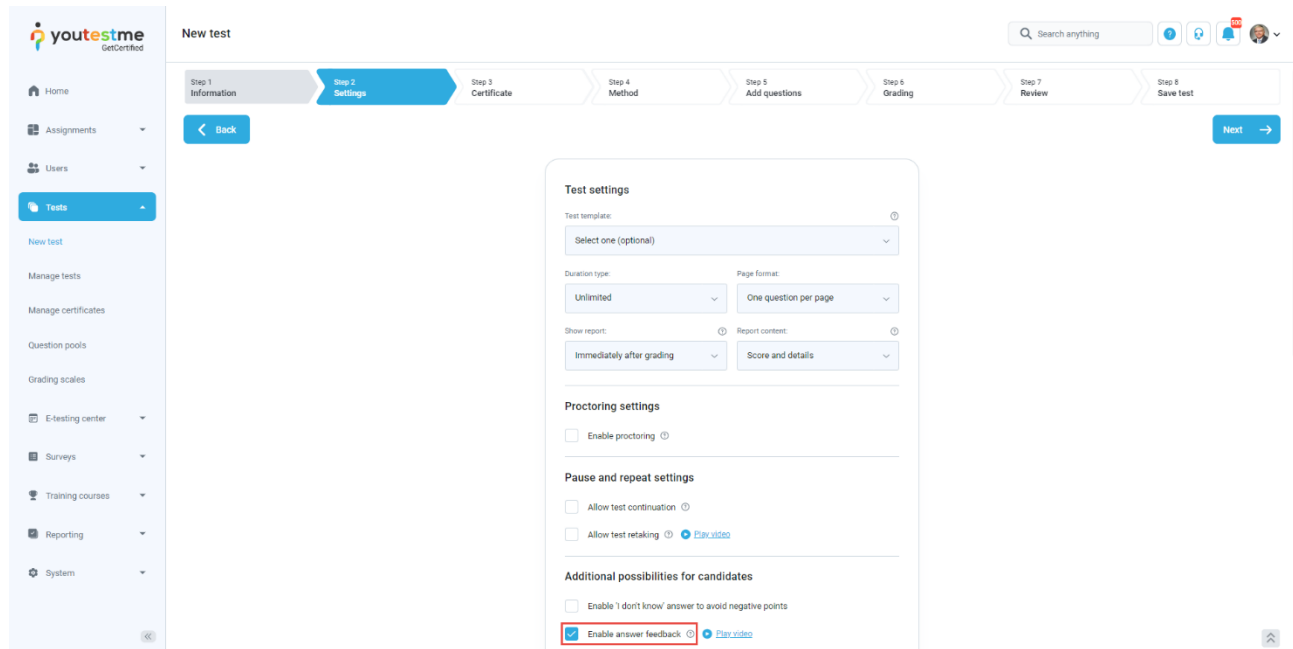

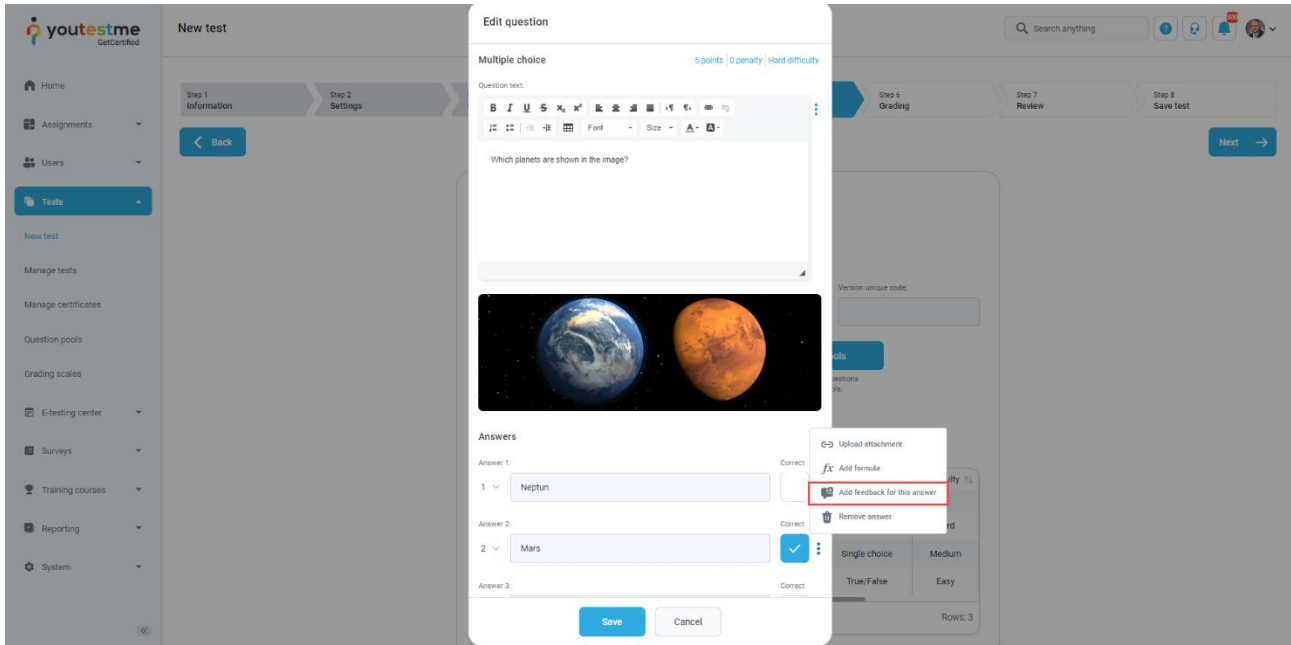
Tick the box **Enable answer feedback**. Optionally, configure other test settings.



In the fifth step of the test creation wizard, choose how to add questions to your test. After you import or create new questions, you can add feedback to the desired questions and answers. Click on the **Action** option to open the question editor.

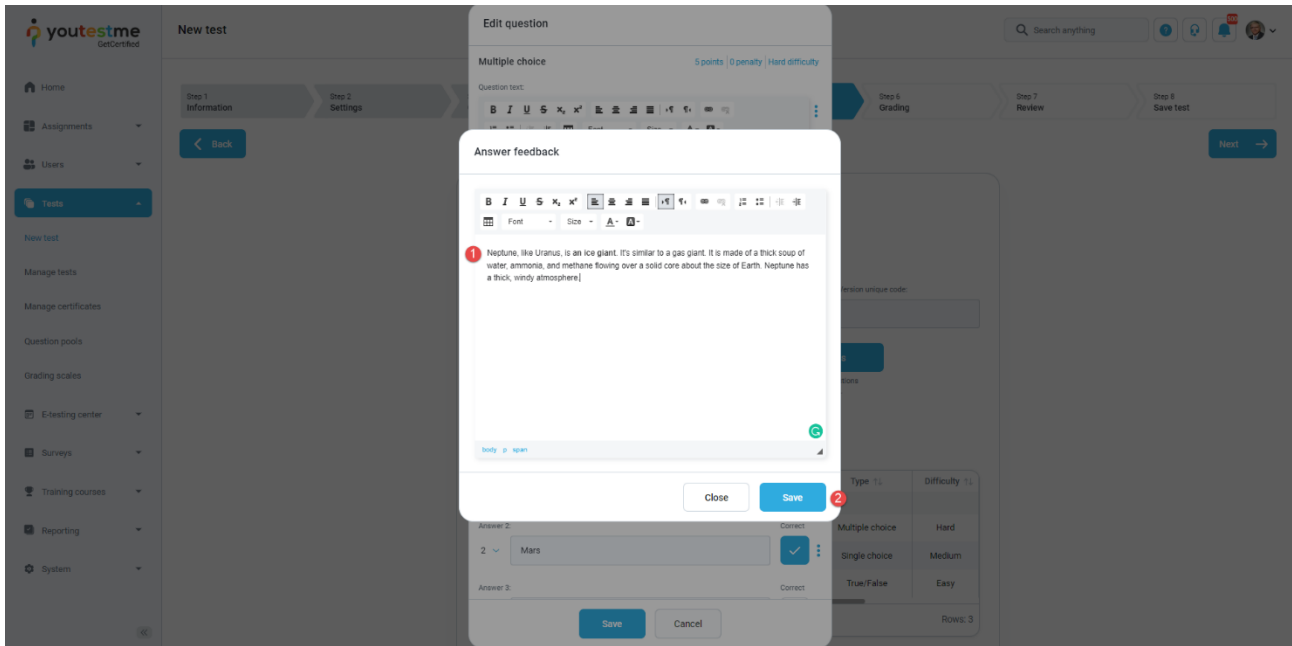
For example, click the **Add feedback for this answer** to add feedback on the multiple-choice question type. Feedback can be specific to each choice option. Please see the **Question pools** topic for more information on how to create each question type.

**Note:** You can define answer feedback also in the **Question Pools** section in the **Tests** module. However, the option must be enabled in the test settings for feedback to be displayed.





1. Enter the feedback text. This text will be displayed to candidates during the test-taking process only if they choose this answer.
2. Click the **Save** button to add feedback for this answer.



**Note:** You can define feedback for each or selected answers to a particular question.

Finish creating the question by clicking the **Add to test** button. You can edit or delete feedback by clicking the **Delete answer feedback**.
