1 Introduction

This document explains how to lock the testing environment whit in a YouTestMe system to prevent from cheating. Lockdown browser is enabled during the test creating process.



2 Enabling browser lockdown

To enable the option for lockdown browser, do the following:

- 1. Hover to the **Tests** tab in the main menu.
- 2. Select the New Test tab.



- 3. Select the **Settings**, the second step in the test wizard.
- 4. Checking the box for **Enabling lockdown browser**, the students are prevented from printing, copying, going to another URL, or accessing other applications during the test-taking process.
- 5. Finish the remaining steps and publish the test.
