Enable browser lockdown

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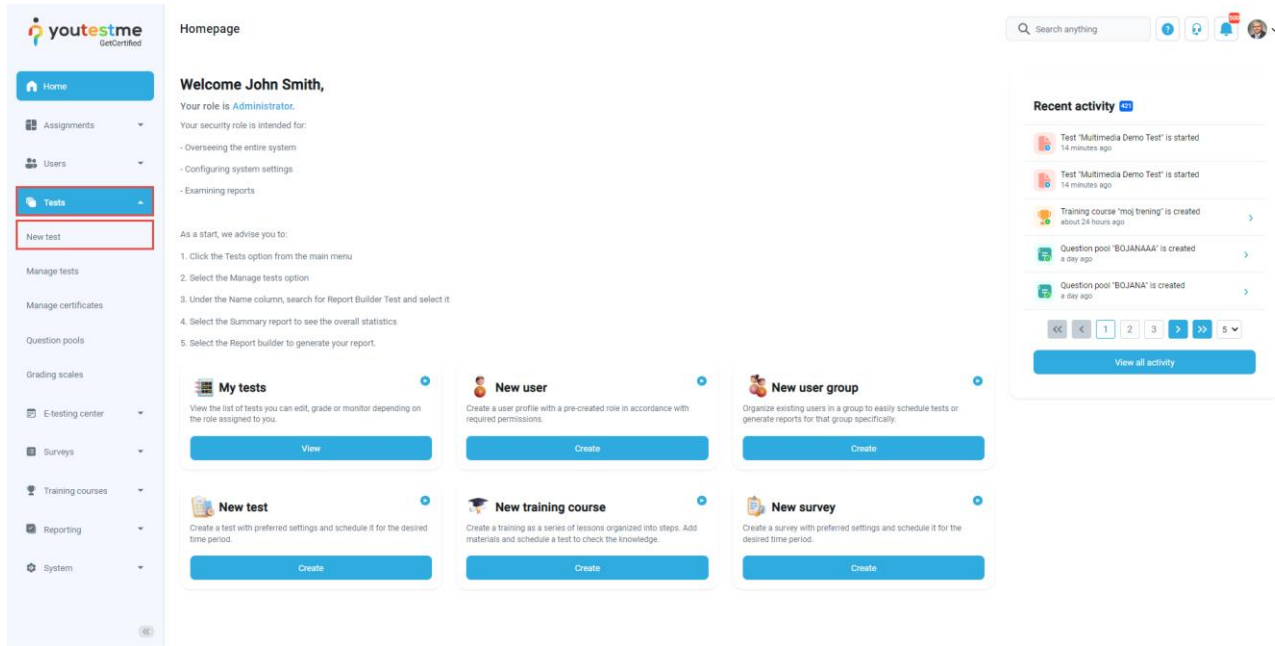
1 Introduction

This document explains how to lock the testing environment whit in a YouTestMe system to prevent from cheating. Lockdown browser is enabled during the test creating process.

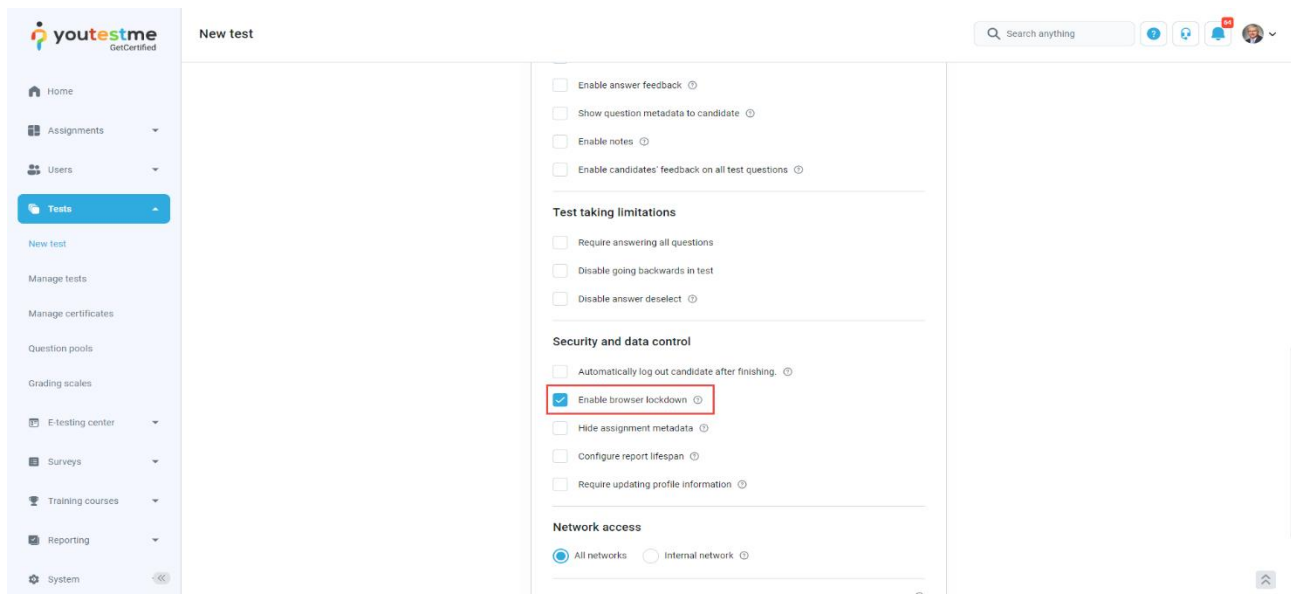
2 Enabling browser lockdown

To enable the option for lockdown browser, do the following:

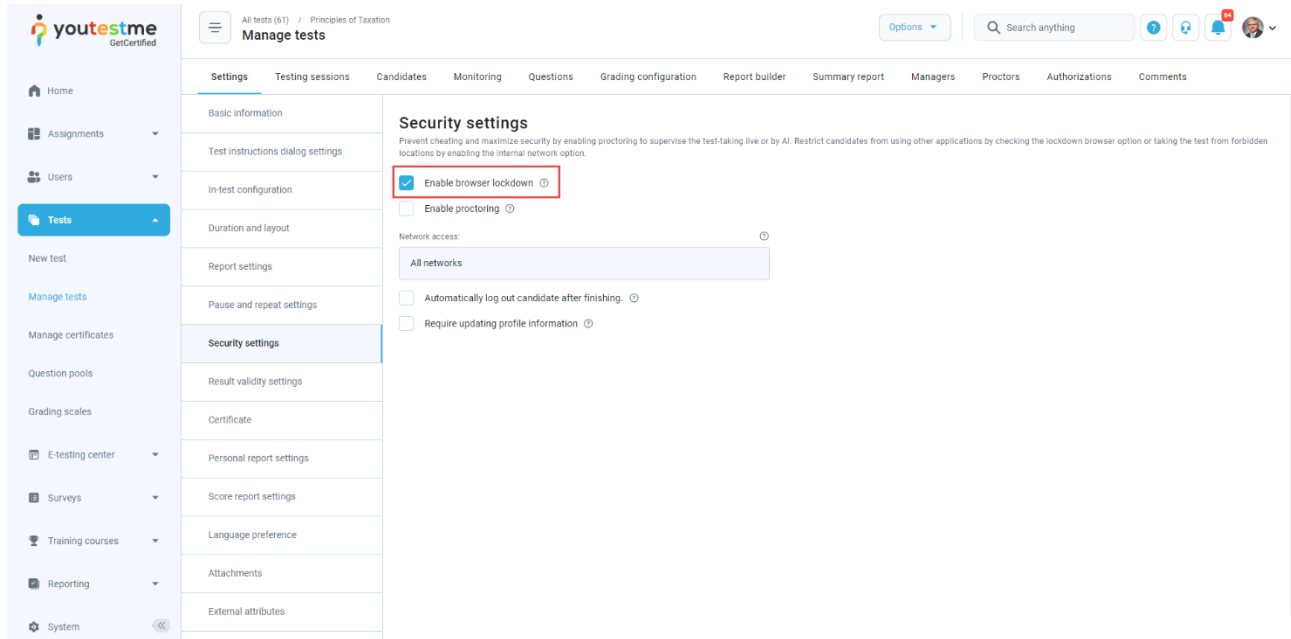
1. Hover to the **Tests** tab in the main menu.
2. Select the **New Test** tab.



3. Select the **Settings**, the second step in the test wizard.
4. Checking the box for **Enabling lockdown browser**, the students are prevented from printing, copying, going to another URL, or accessing other applications during the test-taking process.
5. Finish the remaining steps and publish the test.

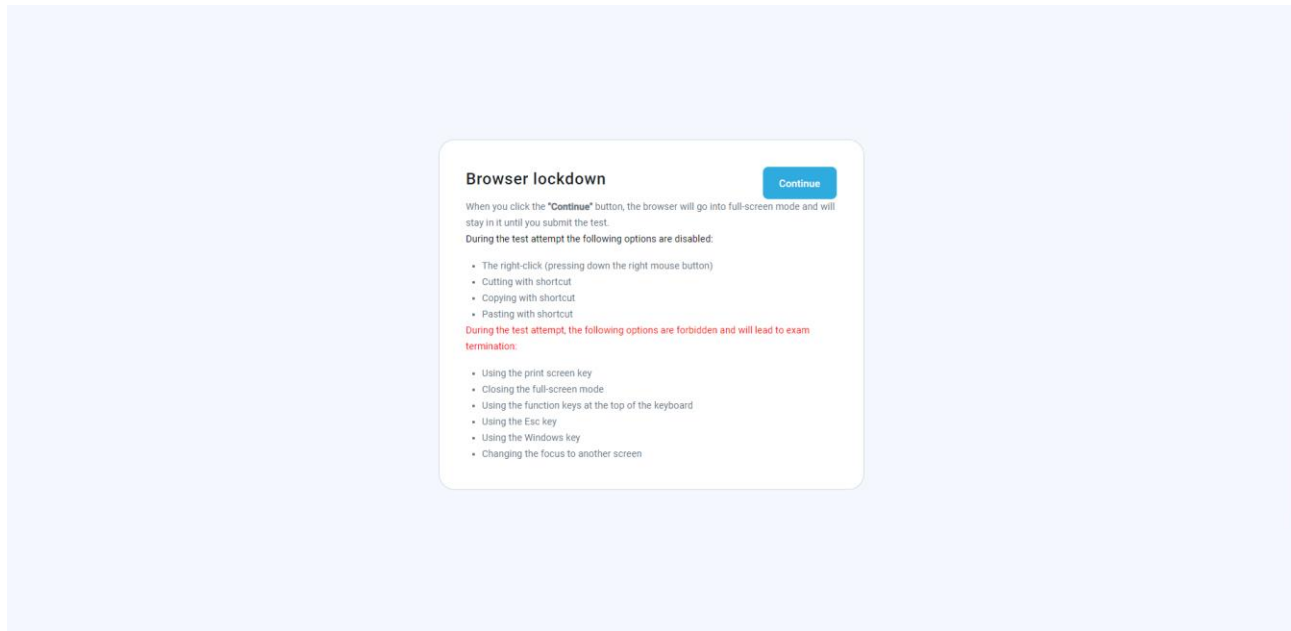


Ensure the lockdown browser is enabled in the **Security settings** tab.



3 Candidate's perspective

When the lockdown browser is enabled, the candidate will be presented with a warning on what might trigger the exam termination upon starting the test.



The assessment is displayed on full screen and can't be minimized. Copying, pasting, right-click menu options, function keys, screen-printing, and capturing functions are disabled.
