Multiple Requirements – Student Perspective 2

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1 Introduction


This document's purpose is to explain the following requirements from student perspective:

- R013 - Ability to provide informational screens in between questions.
- R016 - Ability to have a final submission button at the end of the test. (ensures the candidate has completed all testing requirements and alleviates the chance of a candidate not getting credit due to lack of submission for a test section (if a multiple section exam).
- R017 - Section(s) for an exam: Allow administrators to assign test questions to sections within a single exam.
- R018 - Allow scoring segregated by section with the option to aggregate scoring for the entire exam.
- R021 - Allow separate exam forms and/or surveys to be administered within a single exam site.
- R023 - Allow candidates to navigate through multiple exam sections without triggering automatic removal from system.
- R024 - Ability administrator to determine if questions are be presented one at a time or all at once.
- R025 - Ability for administrator to determine if student can go back to previous questions, or can only go forward.
- R033 - The test or survey creator needs the flexibility to create a test or survey with all possible question types described in this RFI within one test or survey. Example: A pull down menu in which the creator can pick a single question with one correct answer then the second question might be a fill-in-the blank, the third may be a branching question, etc. Text and images may be needed to be displayed for one question or all test questions. The test or survey creator needs to be able to create sections where some test questions cannot be revisited and others can be revisited.

2 Requirements

2.1 R013 – Section Instructions

Important rules, instructions, or notes that need to be acknowledged can be added for each section and test as whole.

Section name: Section 1 - General knowledge

Total duration: Unlimited

Example of informational screen for section 1

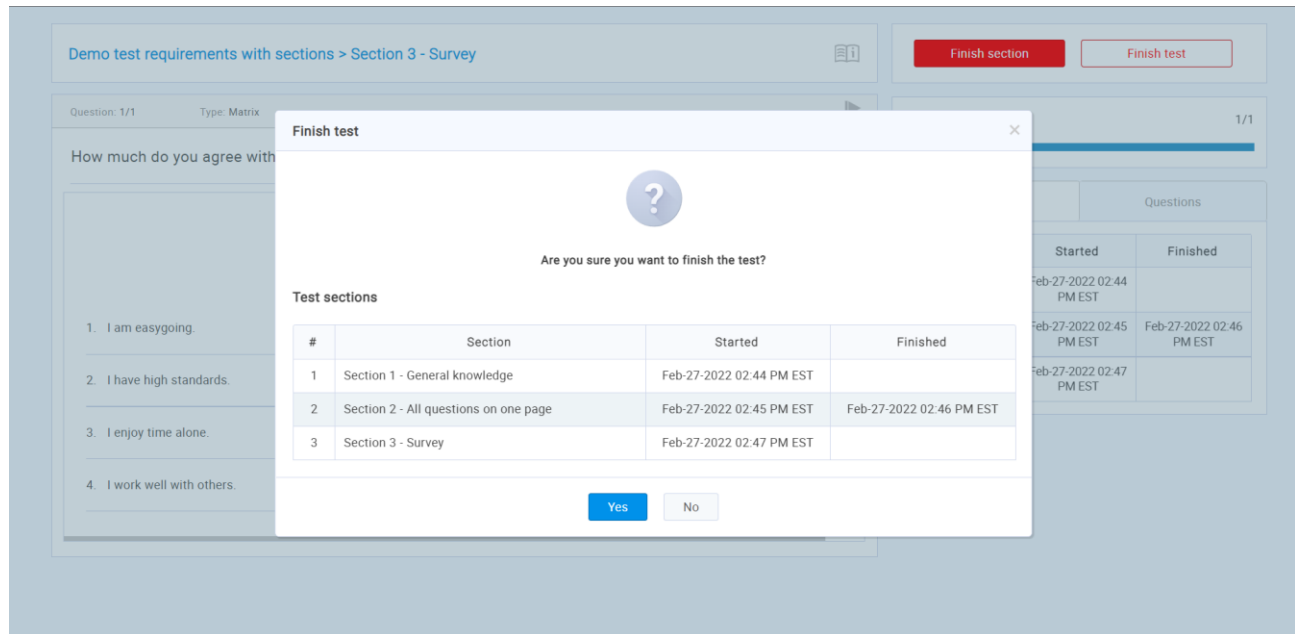
Add arbitrary text like test instructions to be displayed to the candidate at the beginning of the test
For example:

- students may not use any sources such as phones, laptops, tablets, books, or other electronic or print media during the exam;
- students may not open any other web pages, email or any other applications during the exam;
- students agree to keep the exam contents confidential and WILL NOT DISCUSS THE EXAM CONTENTS with peers, educators or anyone else.

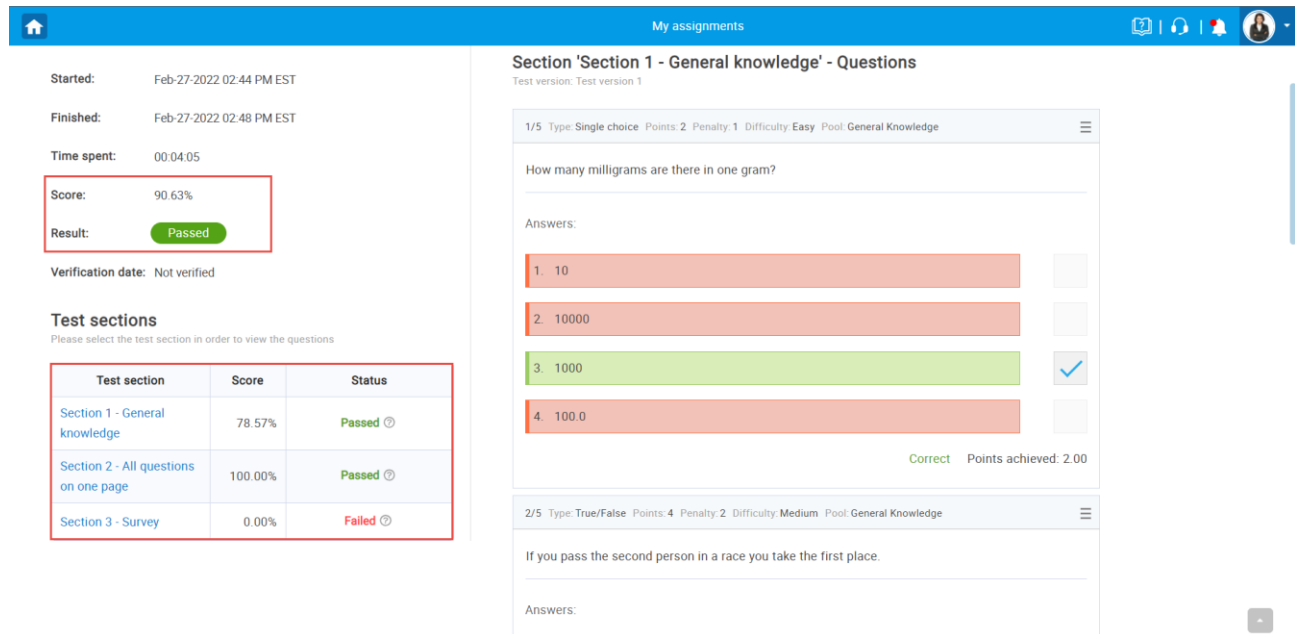

2.2 R016 – Finish Test Confirmation Dialog


The dialog that will inform candidate that there are unanswered questions or unfinished sections.




