

## 1 Introduction


This document's purpose is to explain how to create single-choice questions with variable scoring for each question and add them to the new-created or existing question pool.

## 2 Adding Questions to a Question Pool

1. To add questions into a question pool, navigate to "Tests/Question pools."



2. To add questions into a new question pool, click the "New" button.



3. Add a pool name and save it in the popup window.




