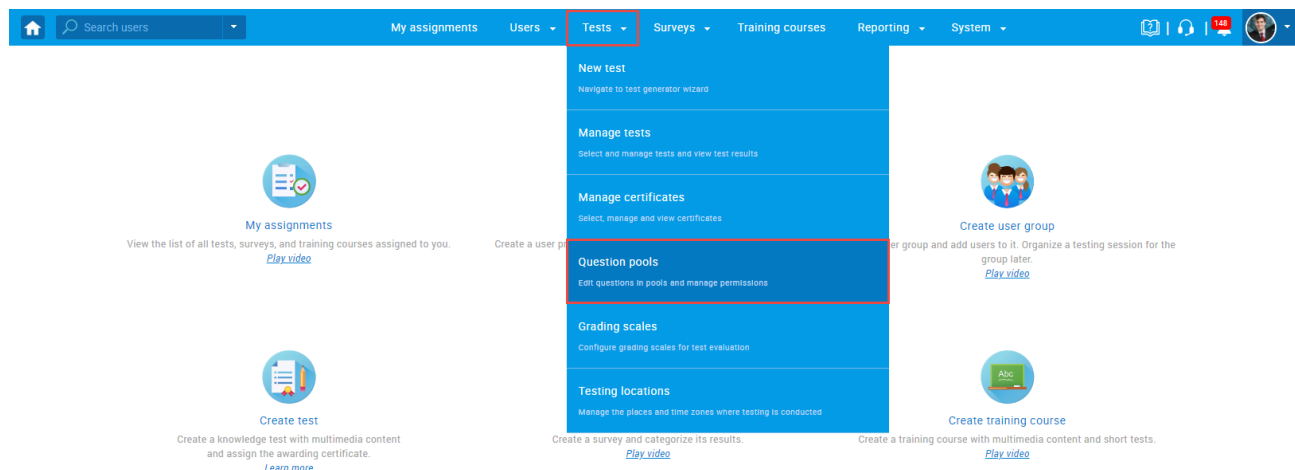
1 Introduction

2 Accessing the Question pool page

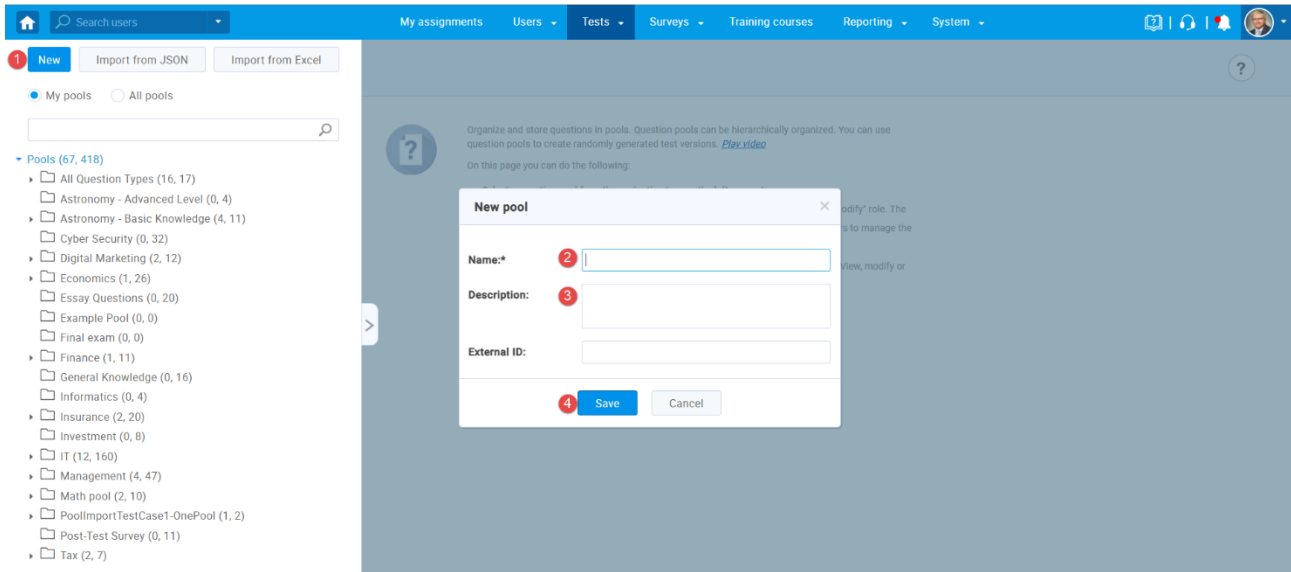
To access the Question pool page, hover over the "Tests" section in the main menu, then select "Question pools".



3 Creating question pool

To create a question pool, follow the steps below:

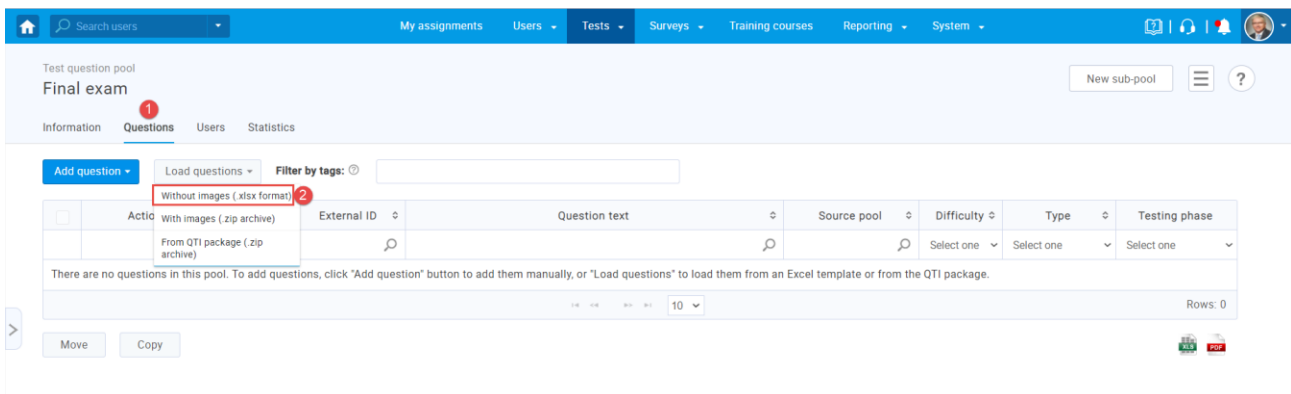
1. Select the **"New"** button.
2. In the pop-up dialog, enter the desired name of the question pool.
3. Enter a description (optional).
4. Click the **"Save"** button.



4 Inserting questions into the question pool

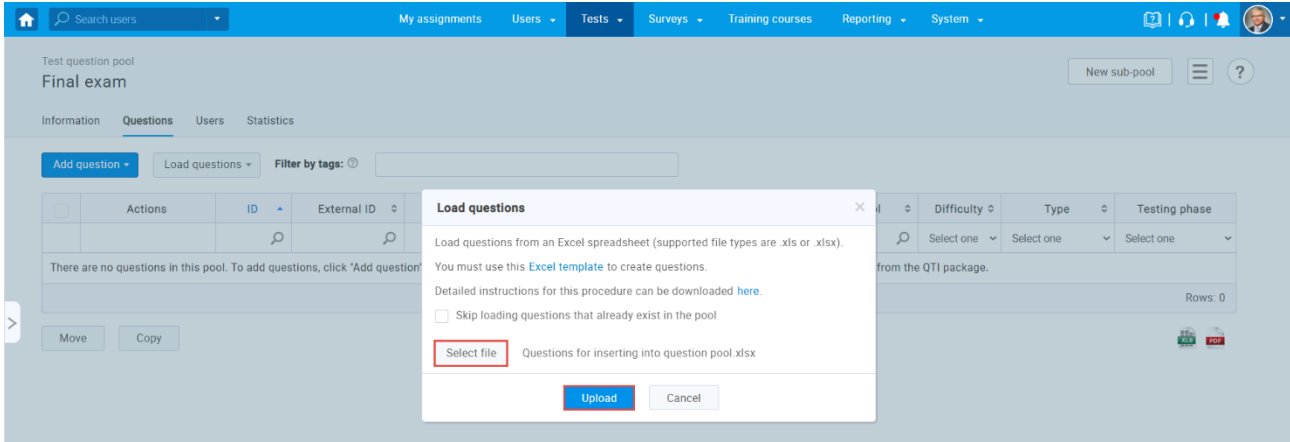
Once created question pool:

1. Navigate to the **"Questions"** tab.
2. Click the **"Load questions"** button and select **"Without images (.xlsx format)"**.



In the pop-up dialog, click the **"Select file"** button to choose the file you want to import, then click the **"Upload"** button.

Note: For testing purposes, you can use this [sample](#) to avoid creating a file yourself.



5 Confirmation that the requirement is met

If a cell in the Excel file is empty but should contain data, the error message indicates the correct cell. For example, we left cell 4B empty in the "Questions" sheet, and the correct error appears.
