To access the test:

1. Click the **“Tests”** option in the left side menu.
2. Select the **“Manage test”** tab.

3 Selecting the desired test

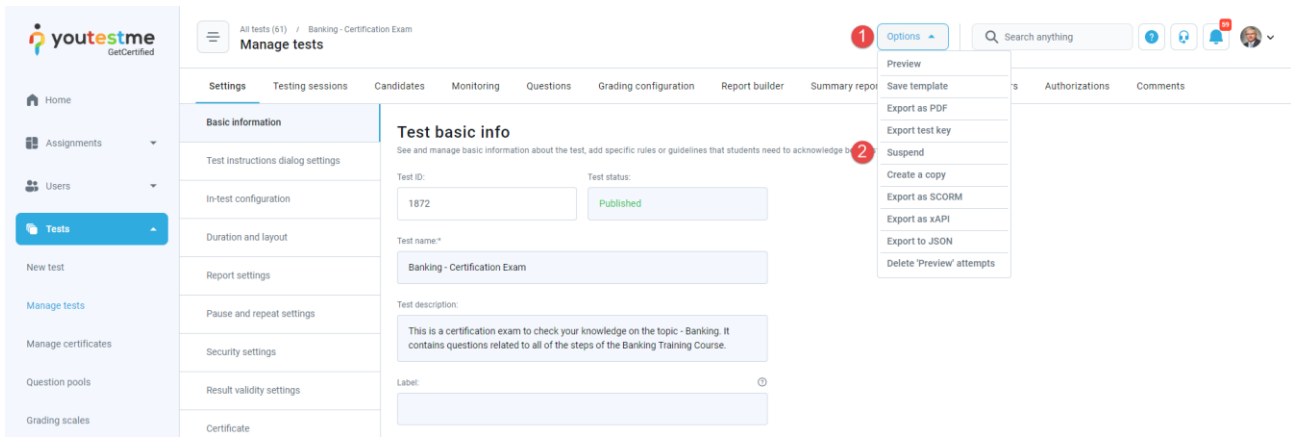
To select the desired test, in the search box enter the neme of the test that you want to suspend.

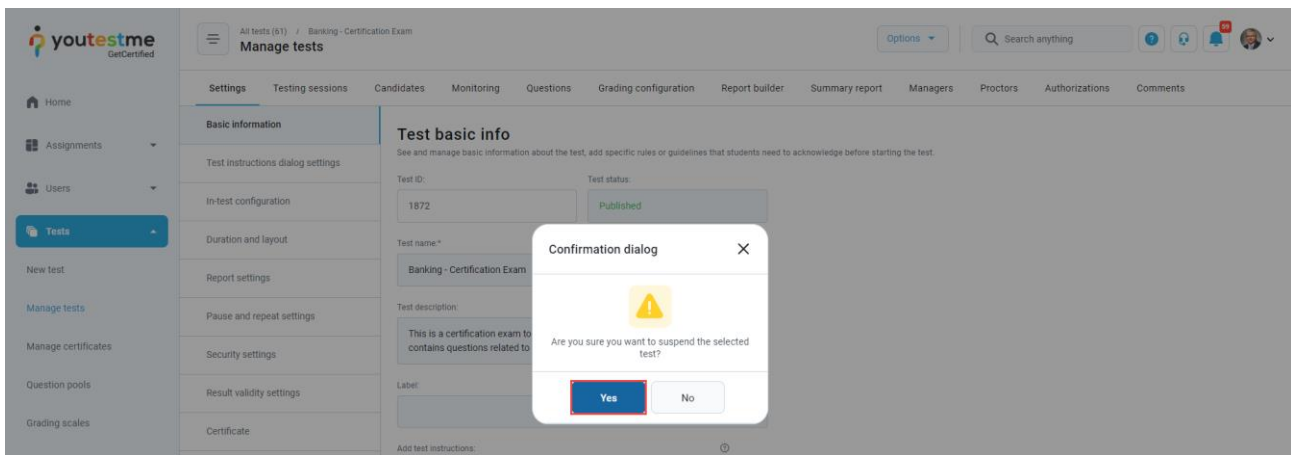

2. Select the “Suspend” option.




3. Click “Yes” to confirm the action.
