## 1 Introduction

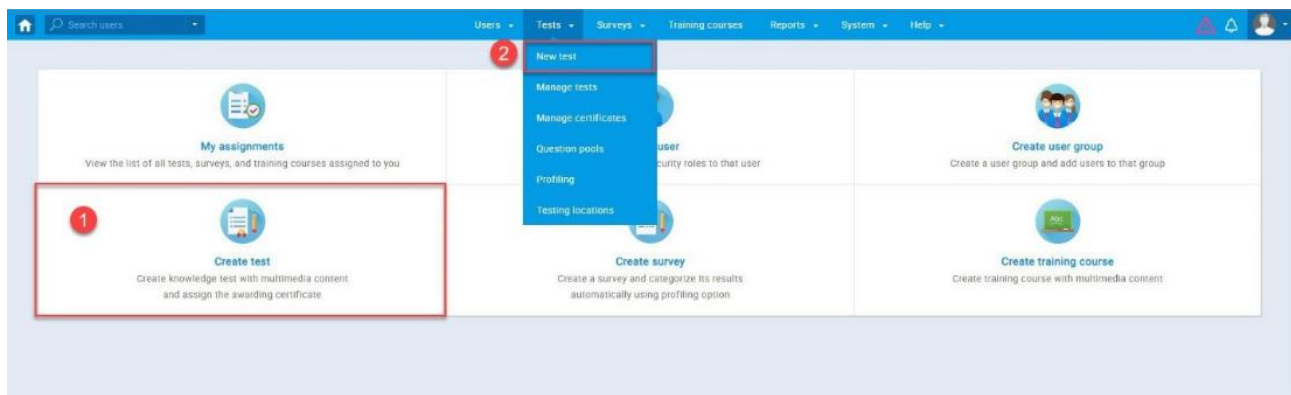
This document's purpose is to explain how to use the lockdown browser in tests.

## 2 Steps

### 2.1 Creating a test where the option to lockdown browser is enabled

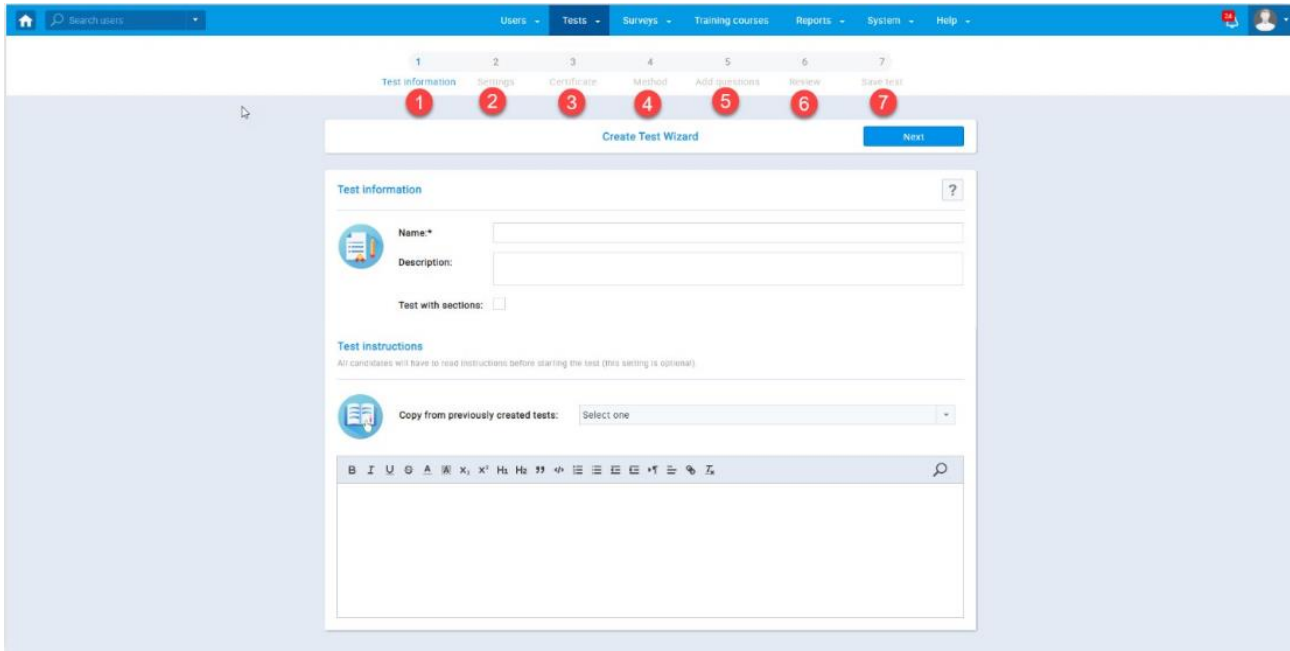
You can access the "Test wizard" from the homepage:

1. By clicking on the "Create test" quick action button or
2. Click on "Tests" in the application's toolbar and then select "New test."

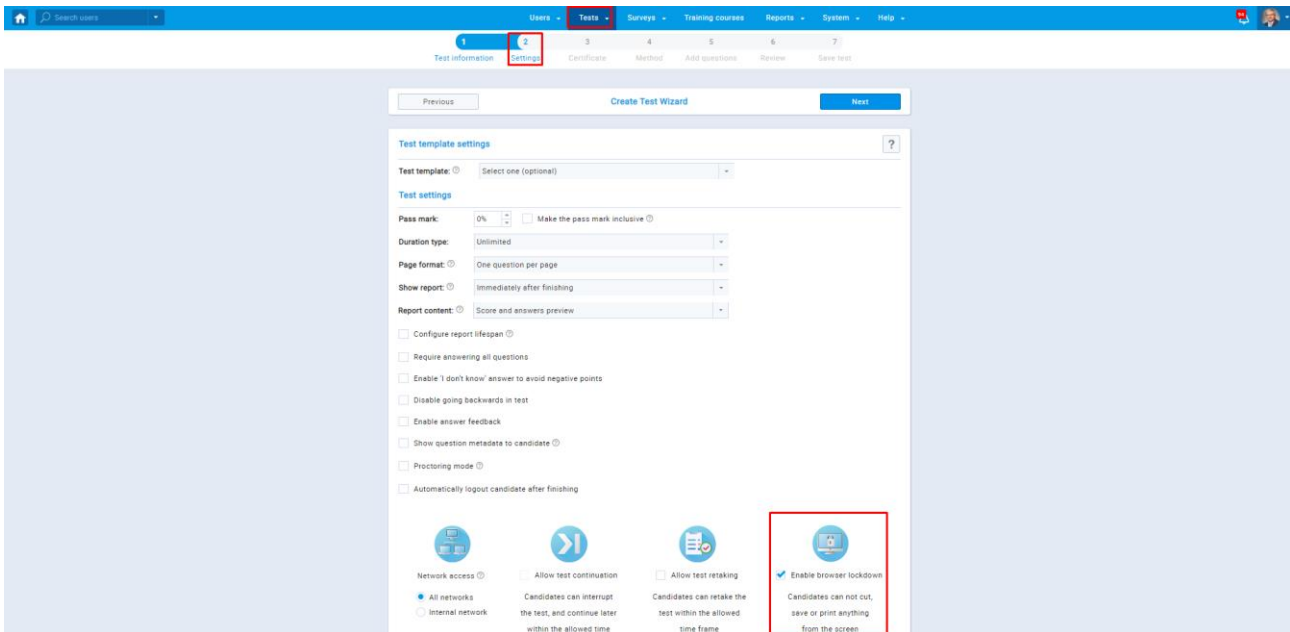


Below you can find the instructions on how to create a test without sections. In this case, the "Test wizard" is divided into seven steps:

1. Test information
2. Settings
3. Certificate
4. Method
5. Add questions
6. Review
7. Save test



The second step in creating a test is Settings, where you can check the option "Enable browser lockdown."



Finish the remaining steps, and when you run the test with a user, a new window will pop up where the browser options are disabled, and users can't cut, copy, save, or print anything from the screen.
