### 1 Introduction


This document will help you organize your test.

### 2 Pool creation process

After following the previous instructions, follow these steps:


To set the number of points to be won when the candidate answers correctly, find the “Points” option. All you need do is type in the desired value.

- Click the "Picture" icon.









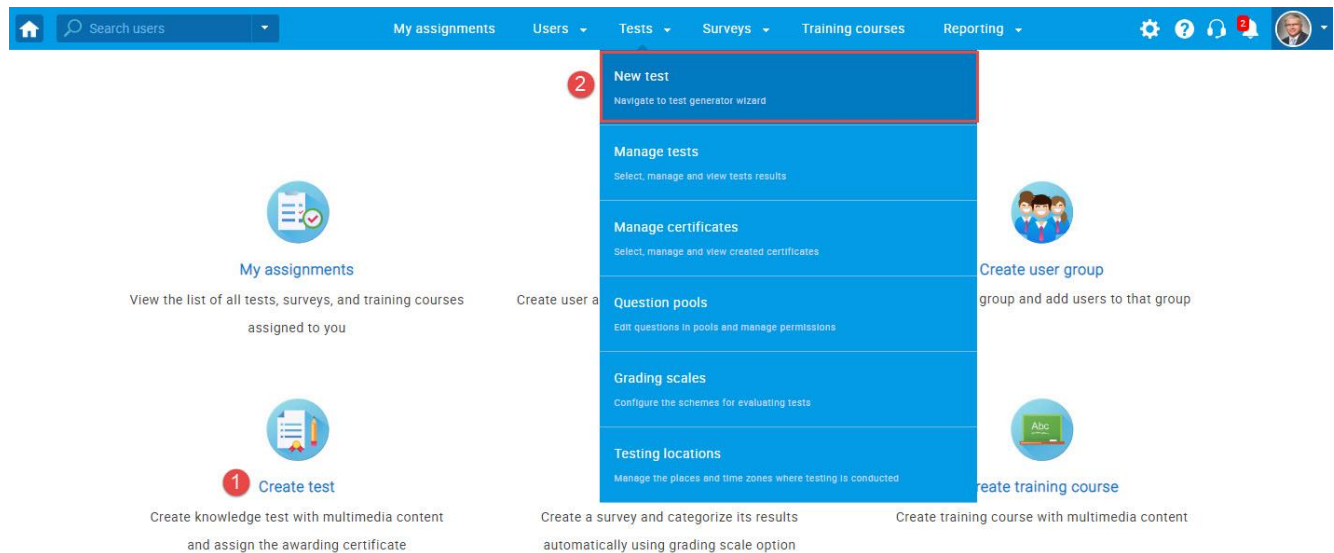
**Assistance**

## 3 Test creation process

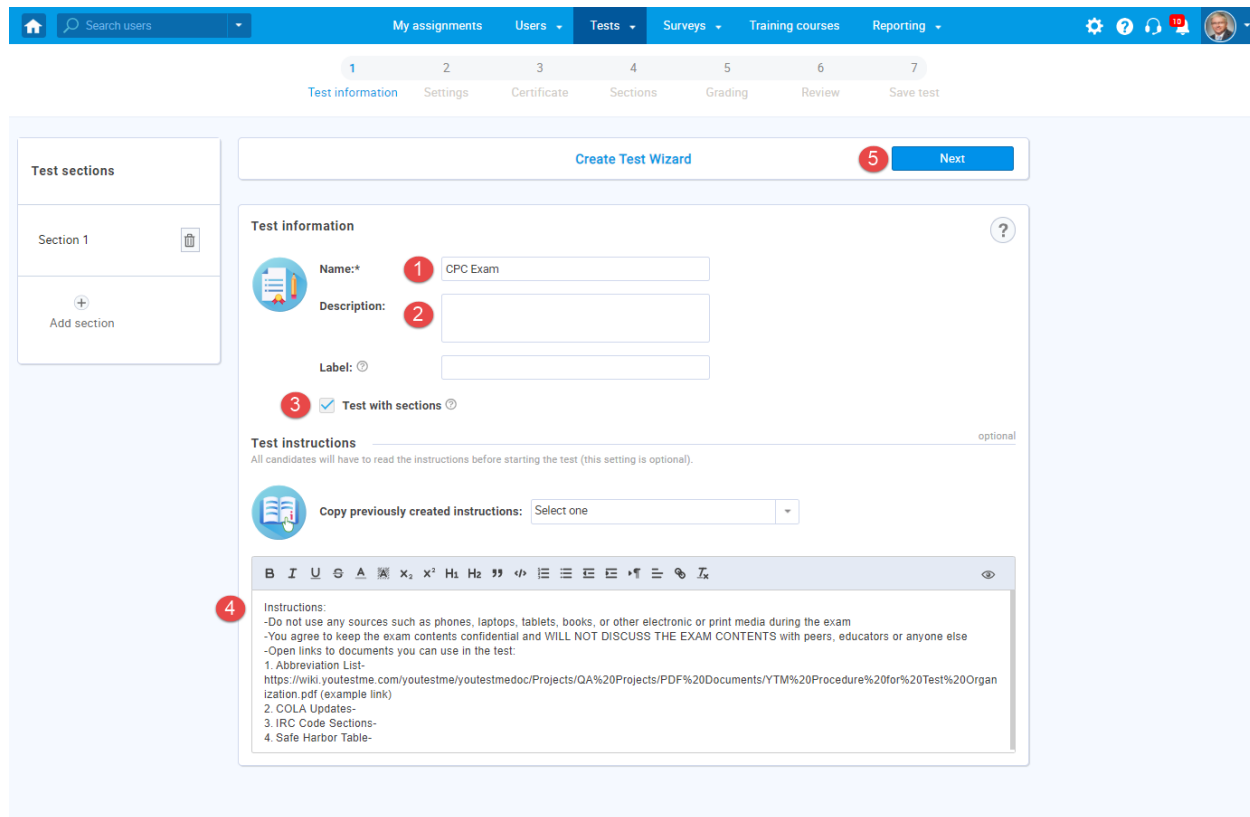
You can access the "Test wizard" from the homepage by:

1. Clicking the "Create test" quick action button or
2. Clicking on "Tests" in the application's toolbar and then choosing "New test."



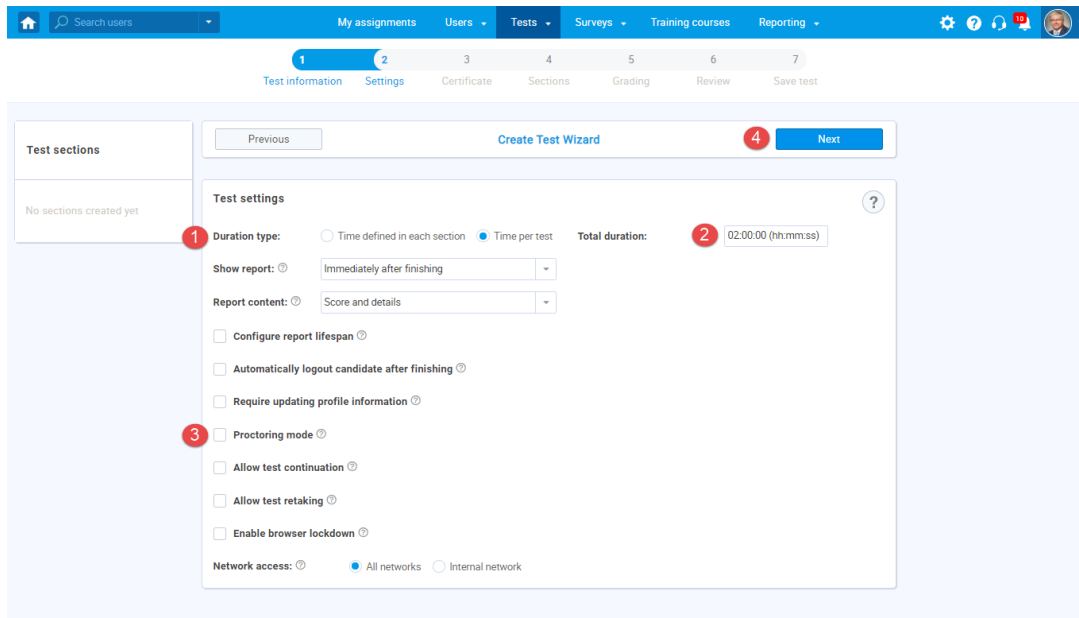
To create text with sections, follow these steps:

1. Enter the name of the test.
2. Enter description (optional).
3. Select the "Test with sections" option.
4. Write instructions for taking the test. An example is given in the picture below. You can also see what will look like the instructions for the desired PDF documents.
5. Click the "Next" button.

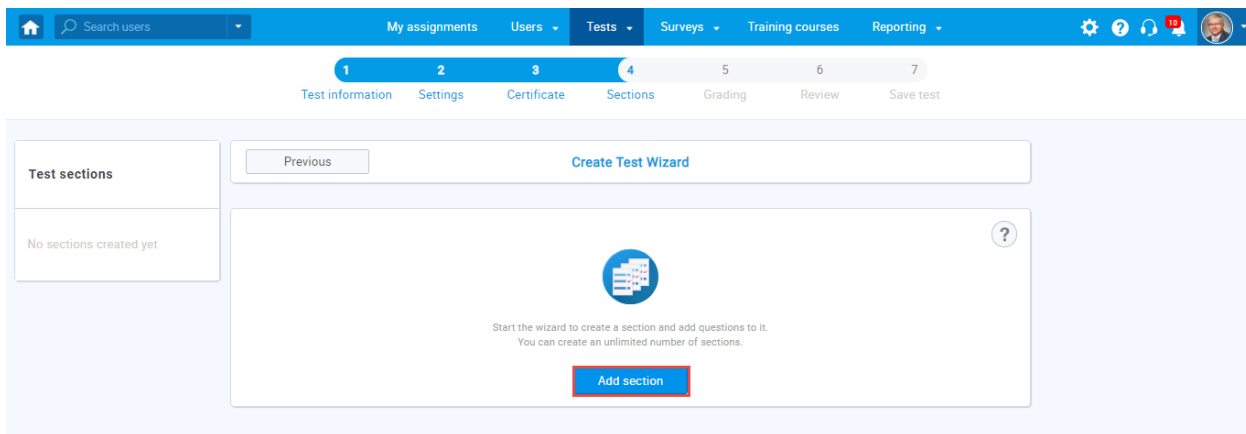


In the "Setting" step, you can set the following options:

1. To set the test duration time, click the "Duration type" option. Here, you can choose the time for each section or the whole test.
2. If you select a time for the entire test, set the allowed time.
3. Enable the "Proctoring" option here.
4. Click the "Next" button.




On the "Section" step, click the "Add section" button.



Then you have to:

1. Enter the name of the section.
2. Enter description (optional).
3. Write additional instructions if needed.
4. Click the "Next" button.

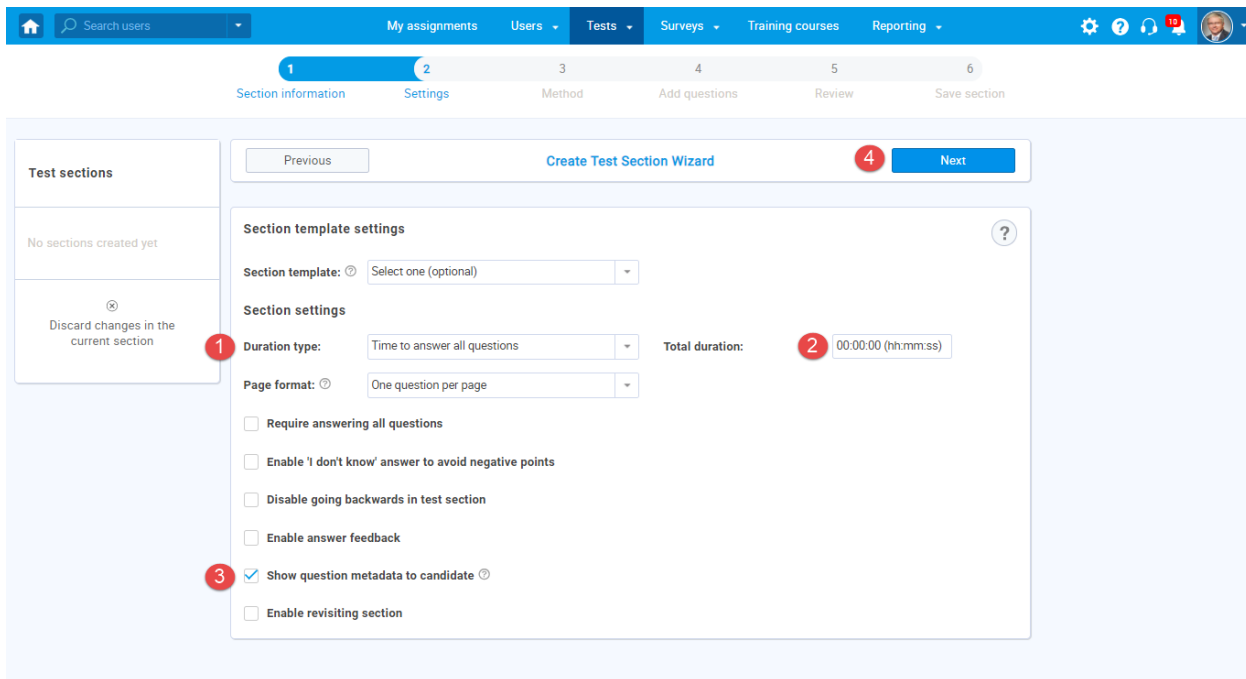

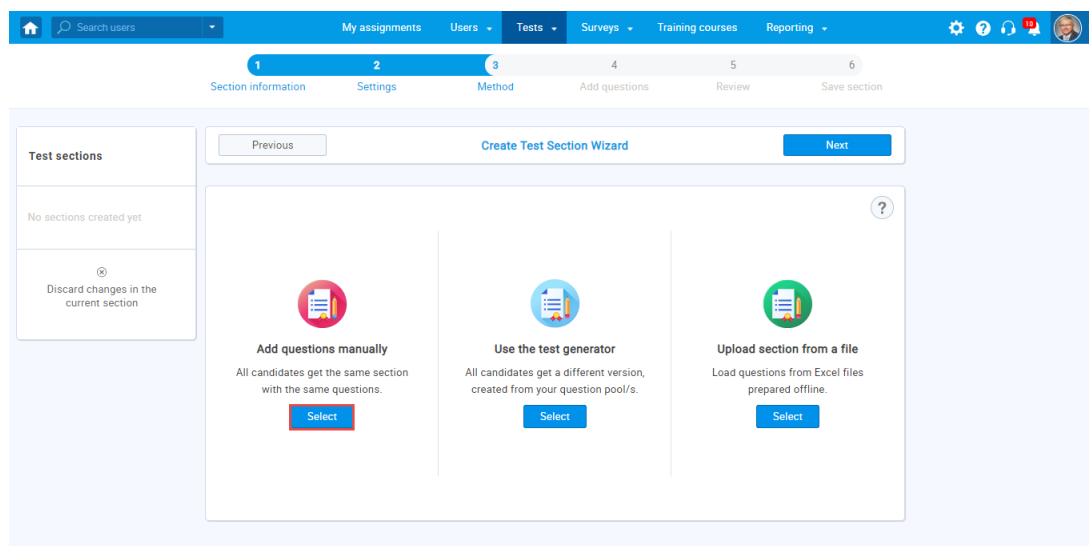


Then:

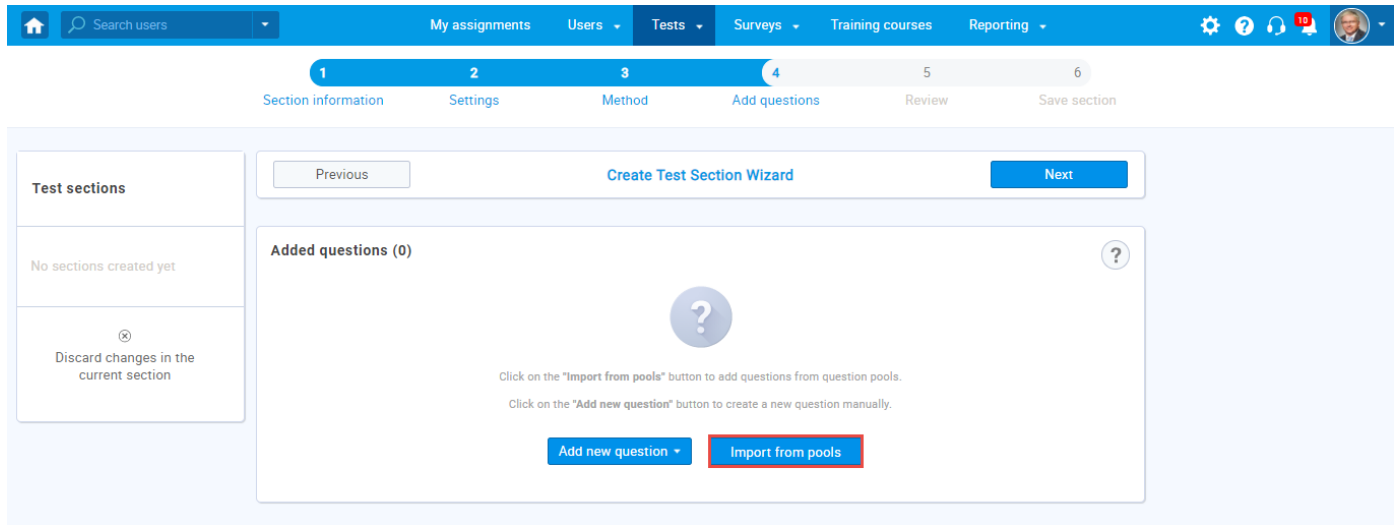
1. If you have previously selected the duration time for each section, you need to choose the "Duration type" option. Here you can set if you want time for each question or the whole section.
2. Set the duration.
3. Check this option and question points, penalty, difficulty, and pool name will be displayed to the candidates during the test-taking process.
4. Click the "Next" button.



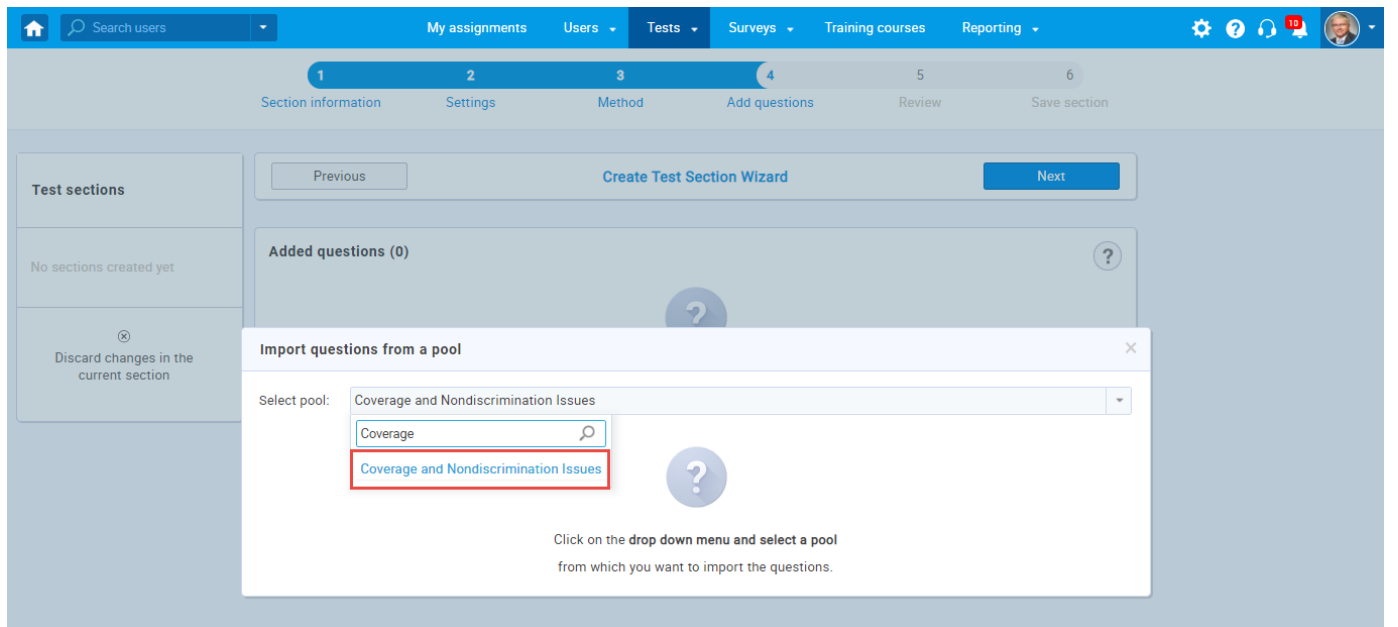
Click the "Select" button to add questions manually.



Then, choose the “Import from pools” button.

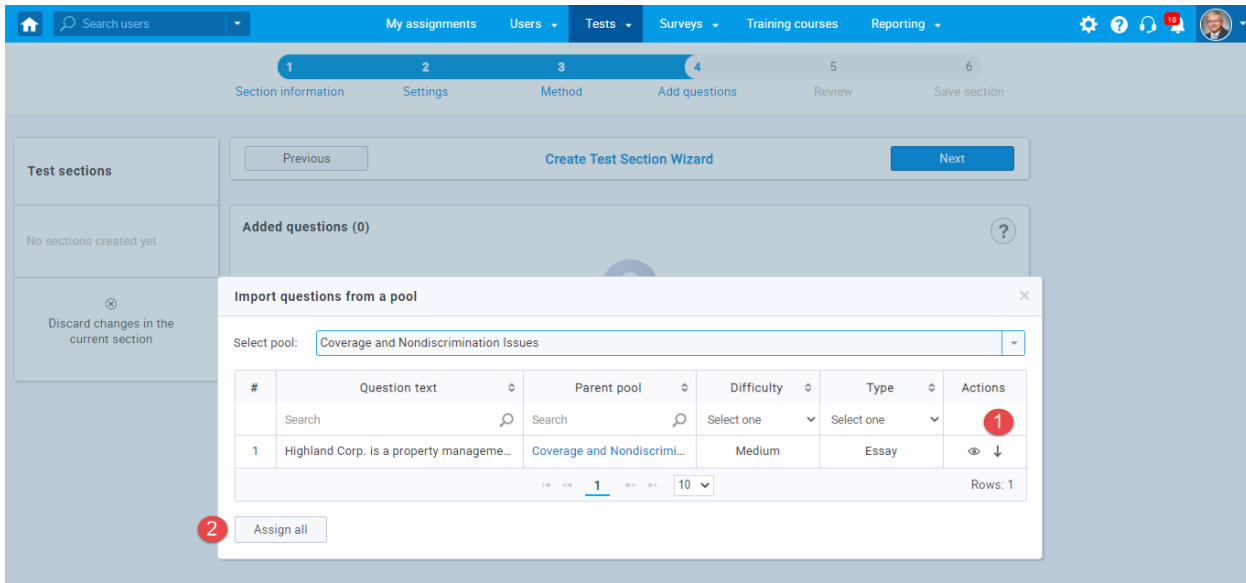


Select the pool that you want to add questions from.

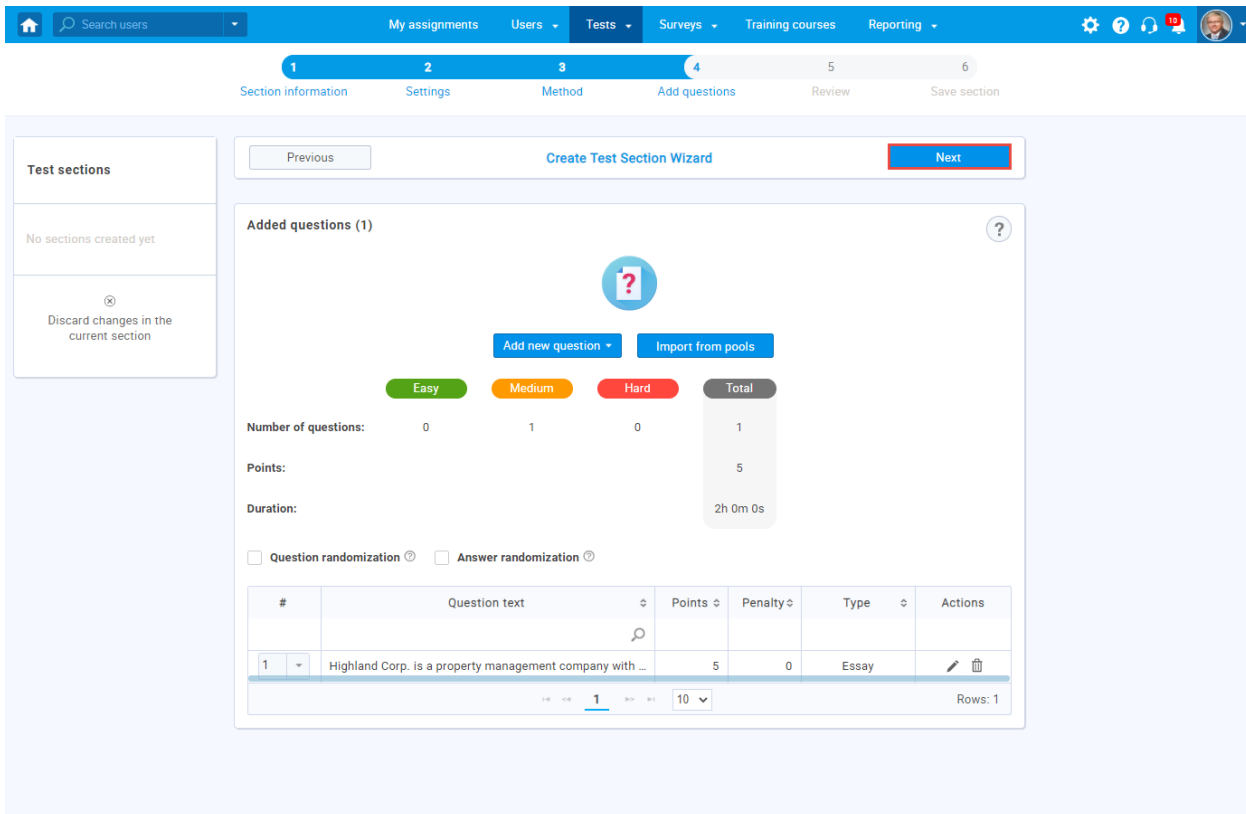


Then:

2. Click the "Assign all" button to add all the questions from the pool at once.

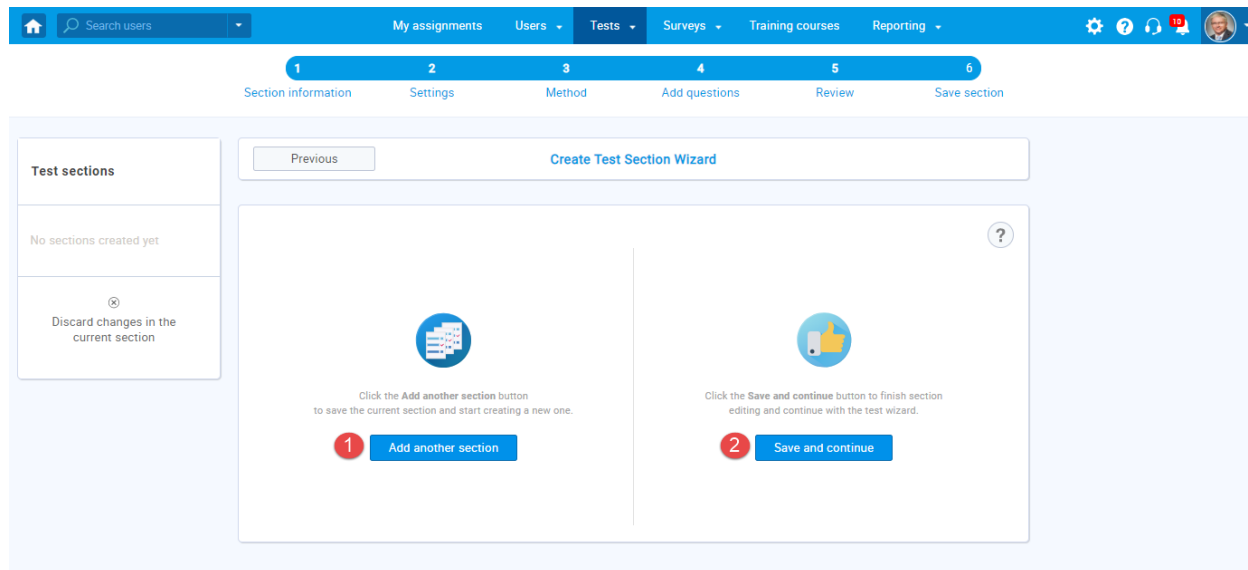


Then, click the "Next" button.



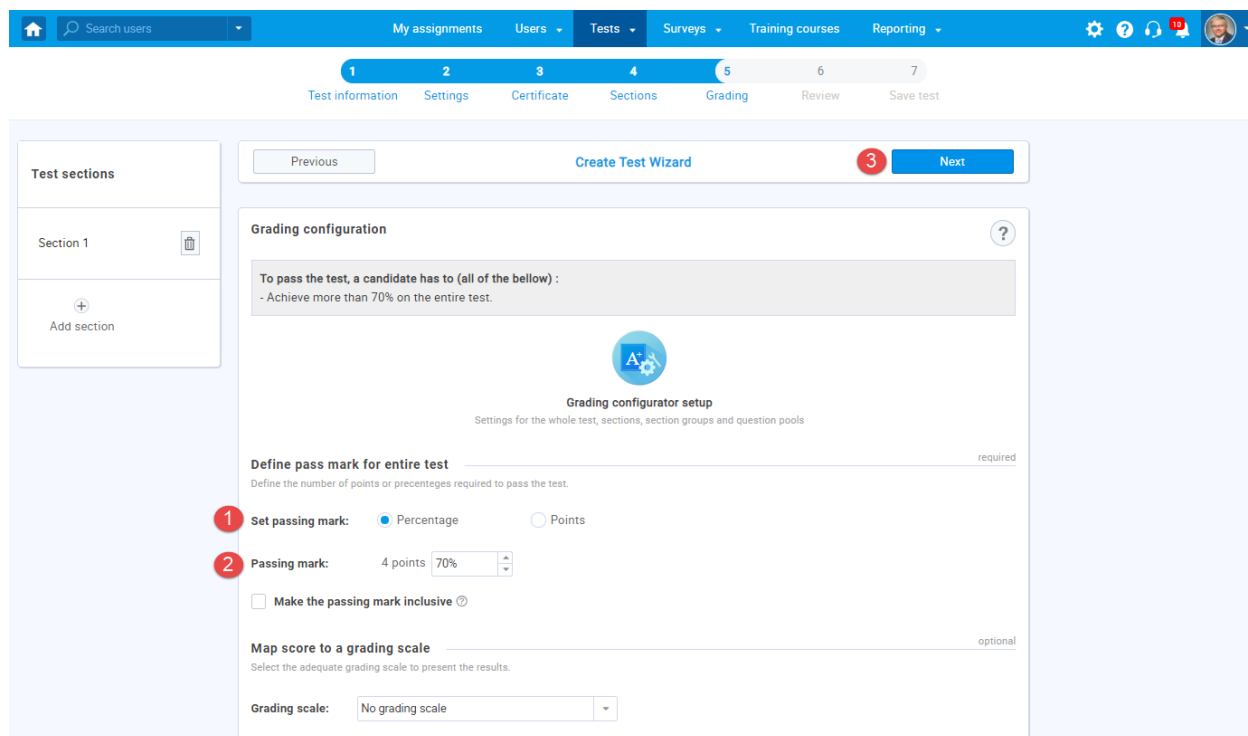
On the next screen:

2. Click the "Save and Continue" to finish creating the sections.




On the „Grading“ step:

3. Click the „Next“ button.



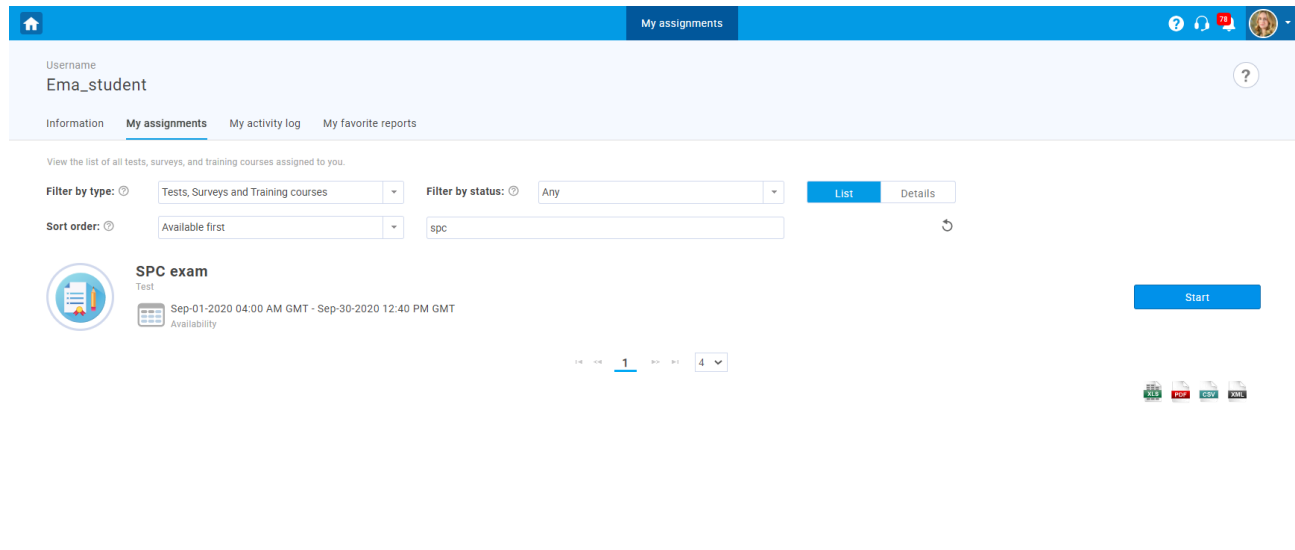
Save the test by clicking the „Finish wizard“ button.



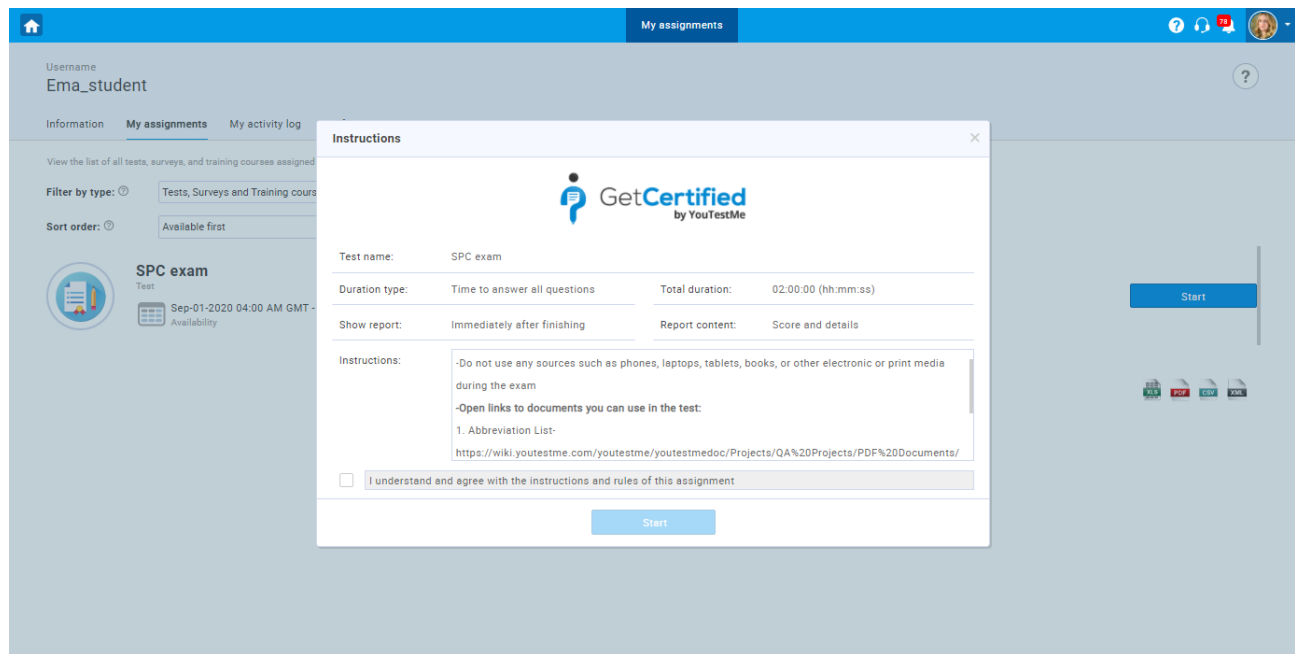




