
## 2.3 Accessing the Platform and Starting the Test

- In case of a draw in points, the faster student wins




## 2.4 Taking the Test

2. To move on to the next question, kindly use the 'Next Question' option. Please take the time to carefully read each question, as you will not be able to return to it once you proceed.








